#### **GEMINI and THE YEAR AHEAD**

Happy Birthday, Gemini! Your Sun Sign rules the communication-oriented 3<sup>rd</sup> House of cousins and other relatives, neighbors, communities, siblings, education, transportation, media interests and communications vehicles (phones, computers, faxes, Internet, social networks), writing and your mind, especially how it works and the impact on your mental state. This section of the chart describes your intellect and how you converse with others or form creative relationships. The house is ruled by Mercury and Gemini's symbol is the Twins; you are both an air sign and a mutable sign and fulfill your role as the analyst, one who questions relationships with people, objects and ideas. Your quick yet changeable mind misses little; you find ways to examine as many sides to a situation as possible. If the scenario is too exhausting, you bail. You share your ruling planet Mercury, with Virgo. This year the Sun enters your sign on May 20 at 5:09 PM EDT and leaves on June 21 at 1:04 AM EDT. Jupiter in Gemini is wrapping up a trip through your 1<sup>st</sup> house of action, enterprise, energy, implementation, innovation, passion, personal expression and self-interest. Health matters improve especially in terms of managing stress. Uranus in Aries most affects those of you born May 25-June 4 while it travels through your Solar 11th House all year. Connections could be your ticket to new career opportunities so engage in your favorite networking outlets. Goals get a boost from late Jupiter in Gemini activity for those of you born June 11-21; be sure those goals help you use your talent and capitalize on your strengths. Neptune in Pisces in your solar 10<sup>th</sup> House helps stabilize career aspirations especially if your birthday falls May 21-25 when this slow-moving planet brings friendly focus to work and family solutions with a mystical vibe. A prominent role highlights your life status, career, ambition and family dynamics this summer; transiting Jupiter gives this house a big boost and then aligns with Saturn putting extra pressure or responsibility on you. This transit means you go inside to look at how your actions affect productivity and make

needed adjustments. If you get a new boss or the dynamic changes because someone leaves, your insight proves valuable in solving workplace matters. Evaluate the status quo. Pluto in Capricorn connects with Geminis born May 29-June 2 in your solar 8th House of finances, debt, estate matters, joint assets, winnings, wills, sex, regeneration, and psychological depth. Some Geminis will be tested to make sure you stick with goals involving debt reduction, spending habits and investments. Pluto is going to clash again this year with transiting Uranus in Aries in your solar 11th House of goals this May and in early November suggesting unplanned expenses, income adjustments, and financial belt-tightening. Be sure you have a savings plan for emergencies in place. Friends or other contacts may want to hit you up for a loan or ask you to co-sign one and your chart does not show this as a good time to do so; say no; ditto to new investments. The first few degrees of your sign fall under the waning influence of the November 28 lunar eclipse in Gemini which occurs in your solar 1st House of self, motivation, personal appearance, and determination making this a time of great personal achievement for what you started last year. Any goals you had to change your personal appearance are ready for judgment on May 25 when the full moon eclipse in Sagittarius wraps up this cycle of activity that has called attention to your 1st and 7th houses for the last two years. These houses relate to commitment and highlight decisions you have to make along those lines. This particular eclipse is either a relationship generator or a disconnector. Some Geminis may meet the love of your life through associates or form a solid business partnership. On the April 25<sup>th</sup> a partial lunar eclipse in Scorpio stirred up activity in your 6<sup>th</sup> house of work, health, colleagues, fitness and nutrition and pets. Conditions surrounding these themes play out through November 3 when another eclipse, this one a Solar Eclipse occurs again in Scorpio and influences this department for at least 6 months in 2014. ### May 20-JUNE 21 PLANET ACTIVITY

High Intensity phase! Coverage of the planets in this cycle includes the third eclipse in a month when the partial lunar eclipse takes place on May 25 EDT in Sagittarius. Lunar eclipses bring out emotional issues since they occur when the Moon is full. Be sure to rid yourself of any fears at the time of the Full Moon and replace the fear with what you would like to have in your life. Make a list of what you want to release and visualize the replacement conditions. It works. Mercury speeds through Gemini from May 16-31 and enters Cancer on June 1; Venus occupies Gemini through June 2 and moves to Cancer during this cycle. Many beautiful and graceful people are born with Venus conjunct the Sun. Mars leaves Taurus on May 31 and enters Gemini where it stays throughout June. Jupiter in Gemini wraps up a cycle we have not seen in 12 years on June 24 and turns the baton over to Cancer where it resides until July 2014. Late born Geminis have opportunities to reap rewards during this cycle and then Cancers born June 21-22 benefit from the healing vibes and expansive properties of Jupiter. Saturn in Scorpio is retrograde throughout this cycle and revisits issues that are on the table for Scorpios born October 27-29 and Aguarians, Leos and Tauruses born around 5-6 degrees of their signs. Pisces and Cancers born in late February and late June benefit from a prosperity cycle. Uranus in Aries travels at 11 and 12 degrees in harsh aspect to Pluto in Capricorn; those born under the signs Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn or with planets at the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> degree could see important matters or life changing events heat up in the next several weeks - the aspect plays out all year. Right now Uranus is one of the main triggers in the deadly tornados and twisters that are wreaking havoc in the plains of Oklahoma and Kansas.

An example of how these hard aspects to planets affect our country is playing out right now - the U.S. Cancer Sun is at 12 degrees. No one will deny that May is proving to be a taxing month for President Obama with major problems cropping up in terms of a trifecta of scandals plus one: security breaches with reporters' records, IRS intimidation of Tea Party groups and emerging Benghazi reports. And then there is the uncooperative, stalemated Congress that avoids concurrence like the plague. Look for another unstable current from June 8-16. Avoid making agreements that are likely to be broken except for June 13-14<sup>th</sup> which favor communication. Neptune in Pisces goes retrograde on June 7 but manages to do so under circumstances that favor love and harmony with a positive vibe to Venus. This planet conjoins the Suns of Pisces born February 23-25 inspiring imagination and giving you an opportunity to develop plans and dreams that play out in 2013-14. Check the dosage level and

compatibility of medications during this period especially if you notice allergic reactions. Pluto in retrograde motion during this cycle moves slowly in Capricorn on the Sun of members born at the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> degrees of the sign, approximately December 31-January 3 - the message during this period is to manage new directions while living in the moment as you fine tune pending matters. Even though you may feel restless and raring to go, take your time in studying and researching information that will help you achieve desired goals. Similar information applies to other members of cardinal signs, Aries, Cancer and Libra with planets at 1012 degrees. From a political standpoint the cycle could remain volatile; more information could emerge regarding financial disclosures and funding as we move toward summer. Chiron in Pisces turns stationary retrograde at 13 degrees on June 16 bringing lingering hurts to the surface for Pisces born around the 2-4<sup>th</sup> of March. Release and let go to avoid allergic reactions leading to unnecessary doctor visits; seek counsel to sort things out.

#### PEOPLE, PLACES, EVENTS, AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The Taurus newsletter covered information about the remaining 5 contestants on the American Idol show. On May 16<sup>th</sup> Candice Glover, whose highly activated and intense astrology chart I covered in that issue has won the coveted American Idol award for 2013. Nothing like an abundance of key transits and eclipse activity moves a contestant into the limelight to give this talented woman the opportunity to leave her mark on the music world for decades to come. American Idol is also saying goodbye to Randy Jackson, the last of the original judges to leave the show. I profiled his chart in the Aries issue and stated "With a new Jupiter cycle beginning around his June birthday, Randy may be initiating a new path in life." Dancing with the Stars is still in competition this week with the winner scheduled for selection on May 21. If you would like more information on the final DWTS candidates look at the on-line version of my Taurus newsletter at www.astrologyondemand.com. I shared limited coverage in the e-mail version you received and made a correction on some of the information it contained. The on-line version expanded coverage of the current competition. As of this writing the top contenders are: Kellie Pickler, Zendaya Coleman, Aly Raisman and Jacoby Jones.

One of the shows getting major acclaim in the 2013 viewing season is Callie Khouri's NASHVILLE on ABC. I examined the charts of the top 8 actors on the show and found that 3 are earth signs; two air; 2 water; and 1 fire. Here are highlights of the solar astrology charts of this talented cast: Connie Britton (Rayna James), Pisces born March 6 - currently benefiting from Uranus in Aries on natal Venus, Neptune trining natal Mars giving her voice a big musical workout, getting ready for a Jupiter return through mid-2014, and possibly a new and more prominent role emerging after October 18 when her natal Pallas Athena has a direct connection with the Aries eclipse that occurs on that date and plays out through spring 2014. Connie's main romantic partner on the show is kind-hearted, hunky, complex Charles Esten (Deacon Claybourne), a Virgo born September 9 with clusters of mutable sign planets in every

corner of his chart that have received abundant boosts and hits from eclipses over the past two years and will experience a Jupiter return in June; he can expect work to line up beyond the success of Nashville while he works on personal matters and cultivates an even bigger fan base. Interestingly he and Connie have fascinating planetary connections indicating past life ties and future professional dealings. It is no accident that their current recording NO ONE WILL EVER LOVE YOU has been so well received. Will there be another hit in their future? Clare Maree Bowen (Scarlett O'Connor) the woman with the lilting, expressive voice is a Taurus born May 12 and shares the conjunction of the May 9 eclipse degree with one of her romantic co-stars, Taurus Jonathan Jackson (bad boy but repentant Avery Barkley), born May 11. The gift of music unites them in several other areas and boosts their star power over the next few years; Both have fire sign Moons affected by ongoing and previous eclipses; both have Gemini placements that received a boost from Jupiter this past year and eclipse contact; their mutual Gemini Mercury shows ease in communicating and both are receiving a direct blast from Pluto in Capricorn on their many Capricorn placements. Clare's other romantic partner is emotive UK-born Sam Palladio (Gunnar Scott), a Scorpio born November 21. With 5 planets in Scorpio, Sam could use a reading © -especially since the April 25 eclipse fell on natal Venus and Saturn and is currently on his natal Pluto/Venus conjunction; another eclipse lands on his natal Mercury in Scorpio in November; and his Scorpio stellium gets a huge boost from Jupiter in Cancer through mid-2014. Hayden Panetierre, a Leo born August 21 plays Connie's vocal rival, Juliette Barnes as an impulsive, impatient, take-charge mega talent who wants the fame and recognition as top country vocalist regardless of consequences. Her chart reflects an abundance of cardinal sign planets: Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn with key transiting planets affecting several of them in the next year or two - her career could get a big boost and more music beyond the Nashville series could be in her future. Will next season's show uncover her softer side? Eric Close, a Gemini born May 24, plays Rayna's soon-to-be ex-husband Teddie Conrad who accepts support from Rayna's powerful father to become the mayor and then sabotages agreed-upon plans in a power coup. Eric's chart shows a Gemini stellium, several placements in Cancer. Leo, and Scorpio, Mars trine Mercury (quick study of his lines); Moon in Sagittarius trine Saturn in Aries (now receiving vibes from transiting Uranus). This man has high energy and tackles what interests him with tremendous passion; busy year ahead. Powers Booth another Gemini born June 1 plays Rayna's father, Lamar Wyatt, a powerful and controlling political figure in his community. Most of the season he and Rayna have clashed but his recent health setbacks in the story line seem to bring some healing to the communication breach that stood between them. Powers' chart depicts indicators of one who has made his mark in show business and understands how to integrate and express a complex role. He no doubt has enjoyed abundant chemistry with other actors with his Moon in Pisces, stellium of Gemini planets, Mercury and Venus in Cancer and 4 Leo placements (loves the stage, the camera) and a perfect trine to his Gemini Sun from natal Neptune in Libra.

Although not my favorite case or topic, I have received inquiries about the murder case playing out in the courtroom involving Jodi Arias and her ex-partner, Travis Alexander. As I send you this newsletter she is in court today to find out whether jurors want to recommend execution for her conviction of first degree murder when she violently took the life of Travis in June 2008. I do not have a confirmed time of birth for either party. Jodi was born July 9 in Salinas, CA. Her chart shows a void-of-course natal Mars meaning that it makes no aspect to any of her natal planets

before it changes signs. The only thing that I saw is that it creates a stressful aspect with the asteroid Pallas Athena (goddess known as the change agent and truth teller; female warrior), the one piece of the puzzle that was a factor to getting the truth to come out and influenced the jury's decision. Mars is the planet that relates to anger, passion, impulse, sex and aggression -- and this was certainly a crime of passion with a victim that had been stabbed multiple times, had his throat slit from ear to ear, and was shot in the face. Travis, a Leo, was born in Riverside, CA, on July 28 with multiple Gemini, Libra and Leo planets, and Uranus in Scorpio opposite Chiron in Taurus at the degree of the April 25, 2013 eclipse in Scorpio, showing that it is time to wrap this up via outcome and conviction for his murder. Timing is no accident on this one - the eclipse Moon was exactly square/harsh aspect to his natal Sun in Leo. The press has not let up on coverage of this 17-week trial since it began so if you have followed it I will spare you the details of going over the past from Travis' June 4, 2008 murder in Mesa, AZ, until present. Travis had Venus (love, women) conjunct Jupiter (friendships, expansion) showing that he made friends easily and may have been very popular with women and with relationships in general. Mars on Dark Moon Lilith in Gemini in his chart opposed Neptune in Sagittarius along with that Uranus in Scorpio opposite Chiron in Taurus and in harsh aspect to some of his Leo placements; these aspects indicate that he would have missed noticing some key qualities in the women that attracted him yet may have had strong differences of opinion over sexual and other personal matters. He seemed to have confidence that he could work them out. He may have been blind to what personality quirks he had that may have affected others' perceptions of how he dealt with emotions. On the day of his murder transiting Venus opposed natal Neptune, transiting Mercury was retrograde near his natal Venus and Jupiter (an issue was present that was not discussed or solved), Uranus was in his solar 8<sup>th</sup> House of death in intense aspect to that natal Venus and Jupiter in the 11<sup>th</sup> house of friendships and showed a difficult aspect to natal Saturn in Leo (restrictions, difficulties). The bottom line is that what happened to him on that fateful day was so erratic that he never dreamed he would be fighting for his life via an encounter with Jodi who showed him many faces and moods during their relationship. He possibly thought he could talk her into leaving him alone for good. Her rational side did not prevail. All of the crackpot planetary players were activated in his chart. Jodi's chart on June 4 showed that transiting retrograde Mercury (how the mind works) was opposite natal Neptune in Sagittarius and in harsh aspect to her natal Saturn in Virgo so she had no filter to her actions. Transiting Jupiter in her solar 7<sup>th</sup> House of partners opposed her natal Sun/Mercury conjunction in Cancer so whatever she felt about how Travis broke up with her and rejected her seemed larger than life and she was obsessed with rectifying the damage. One perspective is that she wanted to nurture him in the relationship and never felt he did enough to nurture her complex psyche -I'll leave that one up to the therapists to debate. Her chart shows evidence of jealousy or possessiveness and his indicates the possibility of treachery at the hands of an angry woman. Could Jodi have felt rejection when she could not persuade Travis to continue the relationship or perhaps marry her after she relocated to Mesa? We'll never know but the jury did not believe her story. What do you think?

#### **READERS' CORNER**

Thank you for the many questions and comments you sent during the past month. I am addressing two of them in this newsletter.

Q. My husband's divorced brother showed up for a 4-day visit as I was leaving for work at 8:45 AM last Wednesday. We expected him at 5 PM for dinner and I planned to leave work early to make sure I was home to greet him. As I did not want to be late for work I gave him a cup of coffee, handed him a box of cereal and a muffin, showed him where the lunch fixings are and told him to call me if he had any questions. Much to my shock when I arrived home at 4:30 the house smelled liked chicken and I had the audacity to think that my brother-in-law surprised us and cooked dinner for us. Instead I discovered that he found the four chicken breasts I had in the fridge for our dinner; cooked them and ate two of them for lunch. I probably should have called him out but instead I excused myself to phone my husband and asked him to pick up a cooked chicken for our dinner at the grocery store so I could serve it with the salad and vegetables I had prepared the night before. Later my husband and I discussed his erratic behavior and wondered what is in his chart that would make him help himself to food that was clearly not intended for his lunch and that he would cook without checking on its availability. We appreciate any insight you can share.

A. I must say this is the first time I answered a question like yours in this column. What has been your experience with him in the past? Your brother-in-law was born with a Sun and Mercury conjunction in Virgo and retrograde Uranus in Sagittarius rising in his first House of self-interest, outward behavior, and activity along with his natal Moon in Sagittarius. The interplay of these planets is anything but calm. The Moon with Uranus can make him very impulsive and unpredictable in his behavior and sometimes in his emotional response to his environment. At the same time he can be brilliant and enterprising. When combined with a tight square (harsh aspect) to the Sun and Mercury conjunction he may not use a filter when an idea pops into his head and just acts on it without considering the consequences as he did while a guest in your home. Certain individuals in his circle may find him eccentric or perhaps inconsistent. The Sun/Mercury conjunction adds intelligence yet sometimes creates tunnel vision with the given aspects so once he makes up his mind to do something he just goes ahead without worrying about the details. Too bad you didn't think of making chicken salad out of the leftover chicken and serving it with a smile while thanking him for cutting down on prep time for dinner.

Q. I am changing jobs in mid-June and found out my new boss is a Gemini born June 5. I have never before worked with a Gemini. What can you tell me about this sign as a boss?

A. Geminis are fast-thinking mercurial people who have the ability to do several things at once. Many of them are multi-talented and intellectual - strong qualities in the Sign of the Twins known for the art of multi-tasking. It is not out of the ordinary for them to go after multiple degrees and amass a substantial portfolio of credentials even if they don't use all of the information they obtained via study or life experience. They constantly stuff new data into their minds and make excellent researchers of topics that interest them, especially if they can take a mental break when the task is complete. Geminis often put a team of creative and unique individuals together in the talent pool to maximize their options for productivity. Many Gemini employers are quick to recommend books, films, or blogs of interest to the mission to stimulate the perspective of employees. Likewise many Geminis are reading two or more books at a time to fulfill their innate curiosity of world stimuli. They are brilliant communicators and easily sway employees to their own ideas and opinions.

You may be charged with doing the background work and creating a presentation package for your boss, but your Gemini employer prefers to deliver the goods - they are good a fielding most questions and most have a pretty good memory with a quick grasp of facts. Geminis rarely stay in one place for long either physically or philosophically and have little patience for boredom. Hint. Hint. You won't find Geminis glued to their desks - they like to manage by walking around. If you schedule meetings or appointments with your boss be sure you get to the point or your boss will have moved on with other agenda times that seem more compelling. You could also find yourself double booked on your boss' calendar and lose your turn in the queue. Lookout though for the Gemini boss who loses track of time, especially if you have a reverence for the clock and nothing ever begins on time in your workplace. Geminis are very curious - don't underestimate this boss - they ask questions so be prepared to answer them when you interact. Many Geminis are excellent writers and expect you to be one, too, especially if your boss has Mercury in Gemini; that means that they are also sticklers for spelling and cohesion.
