VIRGO'S BIRTHDAY HIGHLIGHTS

Happy Birthday, Virgo! The year 2013 has five eclipses that affect you through April 2014. The influence of eclipses can last up to 12 months and can begin to show changes even before the eclipses occur. The 2013 eclipses highlight several of your solar houses: 3rd, 4th, 8th, and 9th houses. The April 25 lunar eclipse in Scorpio which fell in your solar 3rd House of communication, equipment, vehicles, transportation, neighborhood, relatives and education emphasizes the importance of learning tools and clearing your mind of worries. If making more money is one of your major goals this eclipse as well as the Scorpio solar eclipse on November 3rd will help you expand your skills and world view as well as open up details about your local community. PLANETS POSITIONS AUGUST 22-SEPTEMBER 22

Look at all that has happened since I published the last newsletter including some of the stories we covered since spring: Jeff Bezos bought the Washington Post, Edward Snowden relocated to Russia and his father is currently visiting; the judge in Paula Deen's lawsuit dropped the discrimination charges portion of her case; Kate and William had their baby, Prince George; Baseball and A-Rod's doping scandal continues to make headlines with no letup in sight and more prolific investigations are in the wind; the price of gold is volatile with the impact of the Uranus-Pluto square; Congress adjourned for the summer break leaving many unresolved items on the table including a resolution for the sequestration and health care; Egypt, Syria and Pakistan will continue to make headlines and deal with internal wars; and the Gulf of Mexico prepares as the Atlantic hurricane season enters its most active time period.

Jupiter in Cancer is now in harsh aspect to Uranus and can trigger negative feelings. It may also mean that things are going to happen so quickly you won't know what hit you. The vibes are terrific for Cancers born the first 10 days of July. Venus in Libra in aspect to Pluto arouses jealousy and can lead to difficult conversations for romance and financial decisions especially through the end of August. Mars moves to Leo on August 28 and energizes the house in your chart ruled by Leo where it

enjoys a fiery interplay with planets or positions you have in the fixed signs and other fire signs. Expect some assertive, insistent, and courageous activity especially if you have planets in Scorpio, Taurus, Leo or Aquarius; Sagittarius or Aries. Mercury completes the Leo cycle on August 23 and makes a rapid transit of Virgo through September 10. With Ceres in Virgo opposing Neptune in Pisces during this period, be cautious of eating contaminated food and watch shellfish, medications or food that outlasts its shelf life - purge the pantry. Depending on the rest of your chart you either run into situations that inspire you or confuse you so ask questions to get the truth. Watch August 29 for a power day or a power play. Syria looms larger as we head into fall and the uprisings in Egypt where Mars the planet of war is most prominent continue to escalate ferociously; also look at Pakistan for news of subversive dealings. Saturn is in Scorpio and most affects Scorpios born with the Sun at 6-10 degrees as well as other water signs with those degrees. Those with the conjunction need a medical checkup or dental work, even eye exams; others in the water signs may experience smooth dealings in important transactions, easy purchase power or positive changes in the work climate, while the other fixed signs Taurus and Leo will have to review current life conditions and make changes because they are coming regardless of what you prefer. Uranus in Aries visits the Sun of those born March 30-April 2 when it covers 11 and 12 degrees of Aries. Check your chart for planets in those degrees. The aspects bring to light critical areas along with surprising discoveries that open new life paths especially for those born on cited dates and the cardinal signs Capricorn, Cancer and Libra with these degrees. Pleasant encounters and smooth sailing occur for a few weeks for Leo and Sagittarius born with planets at these degrees. Uranus is in a close square to Pluto in Capricorn which affects world conditions through mid-2015. Recall that this connection is part of a 140-year cycle of Pluto and Uranus that has left many people feeling confused and lacking confidence. Changes in the consciousness of humanity are feeding chaos as these two planets come together exactly on 5 occasions. You have seen recent reaction to the wild stock market ride, uncertainty over financial markets in the US and abroad, frustrations over power trips and abuse of authority, unexpected weather patterns, and the crimes against consumers using Internet and telephone technology to manipulate others. The bottom line is that we will need united forces and cooperation to weather planetary and personal storms. Neptune now retrograde resides in its natural sign Pisces at 3 degrees. Look at your chart - wherever you have Pisces at 3 degrees is part of a cycle releasing no longer needed life patterns, especially if it is on your Sun, Ascendant, a house cusp or a planet. While it is retrograde Neptune affects those born February 20-22. How secure are you in relationships? This stationary period will uncover the truth about important facets of these relationships, so start with the relationship you have with yourself. Enjoy this fascinating period of time in terms of heightened spiritual awareness. Retrograde Pluto moves slowly in Capricorn on the Sun of members of the sign born December 29-31at 8-9 degrees of the sign; those with an Ascendant at that point or other key planets. The rest of us should look at any planets or houses where we have 8-9 degrees of Capricorn, especially Cancers Aries, and Libra where challenges pop up, or Taurus and Virgo who could get a boost of confidence from the trine to the Sun or other planets. Since Mercury contacts Pluto aggressively on September 14 watch out for loose lips sinking ships and leaking more sensitive information whether on a global or a personal plane. Insensitivity toward women could also be a theme since Venus enters the picture and gets a vibe; language is going to be picked apart; expect revisions; avoid gossip. Be sure you are not "used" as an information source in situations where misquotes make news. If Pluto makes contact in your chart, it is calling for regeneration in that house - no hanging on to a sinking ship. Pluto goes direct on September 20 at 11:29 AM EDT. Watch financial markets around that date as it affects your money, investments and resources.

PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

Readers asked for insight into several public figures and events that have come up since I mailed the Leo newsletter. Note the emerging prominence of Cardinal sign celebrities noted in this issue - Cancer and Capricorn and those affected by current eclipses (Scorpio, Taurus, Leo and Aquarius). Taurus and Scorpio are making more headlines with the influx of eclipses in their signs, activity for the mutable signs plays out through fall of 2013 and the first eclipse in Aries occurs on October 18 which is also going to affect Libra and the other cardinal signs born near the end of their sign. Examples follow.

Prince George Alexander Louis: The UK's new little prince is a Cancer born with Scorpio rising, Moon in Capricorn and a chart filled with signs that resonate strongly with other members of the royal family. Earth and water signs dominate the royal family's connections. His father, Prince William is a Cancer as was his deceased grandmother, Princess Diana; his step grandmother Camilla is also a Cancer; his mother Catherine is a Capricorn with her sun on her baby's Moon; Grandfather Prince Charles is a Scorpio; uncle Prince Harry is a Virgo; Great-Grandfather Prince Philip, while a Gemini, has many Cancer and Virgo placements and Venus in Taurus on the Sun of his wife, the Queen; Great-grandmother Queen Elizabeth is a Taurus with her Sun on successor Prince Charles's natal Moon in his 10th House of authority, one of the signatures of the one who would be King while his son Prince William has Jupiter there; Queen Elizabeth has Saturn on her own MC or 10th House cusp a sign of longevity of age, rule, responsible action and she could easily beat the long tenure of her Great-Great Grandmother Queen Victoria if she stays on the throne beyond 2015. Many loving arms will embrace this new Prince yet his chart does not have the 10th House planets normally affiliated with reigning monarchs. Who knows what conditions of UK authority may prevail by the time he comes of age. For now you can be sure the press will be covering his development every step of the way.

Jeff Bezos: As a daily reader of The Washington Post my ears perked up when I heard that the Post was sold to America's foremost Internet entrepreneur and investor in ecommerce, Jeff Bezos. The first thing I did was take a look at his chart to see how the current planetary aspects are at work. Bezos is a Capricorn born in 1964 with the Moon in Sagittarius, a stellium of planets in Capricorn many of them including his Moon's South Node under the influence of Pluto in Capricorn, and transiting Jupiter in Cancer making aspect to his solar 6th House of work environments and contacts. Jeff also has a large stellium of Scorpio placement receiving the impact of Scorpio/Taurus eclipses that started in November 2012. With transiting Pluto in trine aspect to his natal

conjunction of Uranus and Pluto in Virgo, his role at The Post will be defined through implementation of innovative technology, presentation, readership style and sales, not surprising for the founder of the highly successful Amazon.com dynasty. His 2nd House of income and resources holds many progressed planets including Mars and the Sun in Pisces in alignment with the US progressed Sun in Pisces at the degree of the US Ceres in Pisces so these degrees and planets are making waves and it is not a coincidence that major mergers and acquisitions will be prominent leading up to major changes in late October which I will talk about in a future issue. Many individuals born the first three months of 1964 will experience major life shifts in the year ahead.

READERS' CORNER

Almost every month I schedule consultations with clients who want advice on relocation to different parts of the country or world. Some individuals are considering a job offer, being transferred, marrying, retiring or just want a change of environment; others want to escape from a location that feels stagnant or makes life difficult. A move to a new location calls for significant analysis because every state or country has an astrology chart and the city you choose makes an impact on your natal chart. Ideally you want your move to reflect positively on your life and not every location will. This type of analysis is called Astrocartography developed by the late Jim Lewis. Countless individuals have come to me over the years with concerns about how stifled, depressed, poor, bored or lonely they felt in their current place of residence. Quite often they simply did not live in the right location whether it was close to their place of birth or they moved for work or romance or some other reason. For example, a new client called for advice some years ago and told me how disengaged she felt living in a certain location. When I analyzed her chart and looked at the current location I asked her how long she had been there and why she moved to that location. The client told me that a friend told her it was a good place to live so she sold her home, quit her job and moved there hoping to start a new life and produce lucrative income. None of that happened and she was miserable. Had she consulted an astrologer for how her planets resonated with the new longitude and latitude, she would have learned that the connections were almost non-existent. Fortunately she has since moved to a better environment. Another example relates to temporary vibes from a city you are visiting. Jim Lewis once told me at a conference that he avoided going to Milwaukee because every time he went there he was subject to an upheaval of some sort: mugged, robbed; car accident; and told me the city's Mars was directly on his Ascendant and negatively aspected his chart. If you are thinking of relocating here's a reader question that is sure to shed some light.

Q. You helped my mother with her relocation and move to another state and she suggested I contact you to find out if a move I am contemplating is in my best interest. She said that you gave her insight into some of the conditions she would encounter if she chose a certain cities and that it made a difference in where she finally settled when she weighed the pros and cons. I am considering accepting an accounting position with a company on the west coast. I like the area but have only been there twice for a few days at a time and confess I probably would not be thinking of moving there if I had not met someone at an annual meeting who has a home in the area and works for one of the company's partners. We are not in a relationship but I know he is not married and I would like to get to know him better. I am aware that the area I am contemplating is an expensive place to live but the position sounds

interesting enough and the salary is good. How does this area look for me astrologically and what can I expect if I move there for a new job? I will be making a decision by mid-September.

A. You are a Pisces with a highly developed analytical sense that no doubt drew you to a career in accounting. You are also highly sensitive to surroundings and could easily be drawn into situations where others need a great deal of your time and not necessarily strictly in the business world if you move to this location. I have separated interpretations of your natal planets in this location labeling them as **strong**, **moderate or weak**. Any number of scenarios could evolve if you move there and get involved almost immediately in some extracurricular activities either through job connections or new relationships.

The strongest vibe in your chart comes from Ceres, the asteroid goddess of nurturing which has much to do with taking care of people, animals, plants and causes. It is possible that a move to the area may put you in the path of someone who has children, animals that need rescuing, some type of caretaking opportunity, or reform of business practices where the people employed need nurturing or new management direction, the best stretch of a Ceres theme I can find. Others would be attracted by your warmth and caring and you could be very absorbed in taking care of their needs instead of your own or they simply keep asking for more of your time. And you know that Pisces can be very sympathetic. You have a moderate influence that comes from Black Moon Lilith suggesting competition in the work environment that could be very intense; may also mean competing with another for someone's affections where jealousy could be an issue. Natal Mars has moderate aspects as well indicating that relationships become a challenge here with lots of competition and conflicts. You did not say the name of the company but it might be one that deals with government defense contracts in some manner that would be suited to your Mars line. Situations that trigger anger may occur more often than you like and frustration may set in, particularly if the relationship with the man you mention does not pan out - and you know very little about him.

One of the tones suggests aggression is always around the corner. I also note that Mercury and the Sun are in orb but they are weaker in influence. Mercury helps you advance your causes and is fine for facilitating communication especially in business; networking nets good results and you emerge as a go-to person in the work environment as long as there are no blurred lines of communication and unworkable contracts. If you take the job stay away from others who want to fudge facts. The Sun also creates opportunities to advance your professional goals and you could easily move up the ladder of success. Everything to do with business would work well yet the idea of settling down and starting a family could be more difficult if that is your intent. You would have to look at ways to balance your life. The last planet of influence is natal Saturn which makes one strong and two weak connections to the area and calls for being patient in pursuit of your long-term goals. You won't have any trouble focusing on them but nothing will happen in a hurry. The world of contracts seems very important to your work - negotiating, preparing, executing. If you are a more easy-going type of person you may not like the new location because the job will demand so much of your time. This location seems more suited to work and career goals or even travel here for work purposes than it does for romance. The strong Ceres aspect I cited above could also pertain to pet causes of authority figures or meeting

someone who has been married and has children from a previous relationship. Would I recommend that you move here? No, I think you want more than this location will provide. Moving mainly for the opportunity to pursue someone who may or may be available seldom pans out. If you do move to the west coast I doubt it will be a long term move. I wish you success in your pending decision.

CONFIDENTIAL TO "EXERCISER'S FRIEND" - Yes, some Virgos do enjoy rigorous exercise routines and have phobias about what can happen to their body if they let up in intensity and may pass this message on to many of the people they know - but so do members of other signs. Since Virgo rules the 6th House the daily environment may very well include time at the gym, on the running trail or an exercise room at home. The repeated dialog you describe sounds like extreme pressure to get you to commit to a routine that you don't feel - just say "no" without making any excuses and continue with the aerobic and treadmill routine you find comfortable.
