You are still experiencing the effects of two of last year's eclipses, those on October 18 and November 3. # PLANETS IN ARIES' TIME from March 20-April 19

Mars in Libra continues on a retrograde journey throughout this time. No other planets are in Aries except the Sun until Mercury enters your sign on April 8, perhaps signaling the onset of warmer weather and true spring. Asteroids are the big movers and shakers in the early weeks of this forecast. On March 20-21 the Sun, Pallas and Vesta conjoin sending out signals about beefing up security, defending your home turf, adding modern upgrades to your residence or place of business and adding dollars to funding sources. A blast from Uranus to Juno on March 25<sup>th</sup> could mean environmental or weather issues surface, the weak or underdog could use protection or food quality gets a hard look especially when Pluto in Capricorn blasts Juno on the 28th and then goes retrograde on April 14. Sometimes heat waves emerge after a long cold spell and living organisms have trouble adjusting to the change. Mars is going to oppose Juno on April 7 and stay in aspect for a week during which time the media is going to focus on the courage it takes to stand up to bullies whether in local or foreign environments. No doubt the stand against Putin and his coup in Crimea will continue to make headlines. The Full Moon eclipse on April 15 is going to activate transiting Ceres and Vesta in Libra and Juno in opposition in Aries. Retirement plans and savings are a huge topic of interest to many people. Venus moves from Aquarius to Pisces on April 6 and could bring rain instead of a lingering frost to weather patterns. Uranus in Aries is in a boxing match with Pluto in Capricorn now and clashes with Mars later in April. Jupiter in Cancer creates a stressful aspect to Pluto in opposition for most of the month making you feel as though long-sought goals are out of reach. Be patient. Saturn in Scorpio is retrograde and most affects individuals born November 13-16 cautioning you to make conservative financial investments and plan purchases carefully, especially big ticket items; for some it means a raise after the very hard work you have accomplished. A second new Moon in March occurs on the 30<sup>th</sup> and this one is in Aries inviting you to include on your wish list, demonstrations of courage, attitudes that create independence, and a positive spirit. What would you like to have happen? Write down your intentions and go for it. Neptune in Pisces most affects those born February 24-26 during this time period and then joins Venus from the 6<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> to create a sense of release, relief, romance or creativity. This cycle is excellent for reading, research, writing and a romantic social life. Those most impacted by this cycle have planets at 5-6 degrees of Pisces, Cancer and Scorpio. If you are one of them it may be time to schedule a consultation to check your chart. The other signs in high focus now are Taurus, Leo, Libra, Aquarius and Aries.

## PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The Russian military occupation of Crimea is a hot political story that is making waves especially now that Putin annexed Crimea from the Ukraine. The chart of the Ukraine which declared its independence from the USSR in August 1991 has a stellium of planets in Capricorn in the 12<sup>th</sup> House of secrets, deception, selective disclosure and underhanded tactics. Pluto is on the cusp and two of the affected planets now include Uranus and Dark Moon Lilith. Pluto is also affecting the 12<sup>th</sup> House of Putin's chart (a Libra born October 7) where it squares his Sun. Now a Mars in Libra transit smacks his Mercury in that sign sending signals that issues of control result in a power play with only fragments of the truth emerging in the messages he is sending to the world. The takeover has long-term, serious global and economic implications. Russia faces sanctions from the West and the European countries tied to NATO. The position of planets triggering the vote in Crimea involve Mars, the planet of war which is retrograde in Libra and reached 26° on March 16 when Crimea voted. That degree is critical in the President's chart since Obama has progressed Mars at 26° Libra. Keep a close watch on unfolding developments. When these aspects occur military troops start moving. April will be critical. Pluto turns retrograde in Capricorn in opposition to the U.S. Sun while the planet of conflict, Mars, enters into the planetary Grand Cross of Cardinal planets that emerges in mid-April and unleashes conflict for several months. Very little gets resolved in the short term. The pundits will be in hard pursuit of developing situations.

Flight MH370: Ever since the story broke, the number one topic on the minds of readers this month has been the missing Malaysia airliner that disappeared on March 8 in Kuala Lumpur. CNN is covering the unfolding developments and parsing each discovery using the talents of specialists in the aviation, military and tactical fields to look for clues about what really happened on that fateful morning. Theories and suppositions emerge daily and just as quickly meet with criticism or another "what if" suggestion. You name it, we've heard it - kidnapping, terrorist attack, alien invasion, suicide, extortion and a plot to take the plane to another country. Most agree that we will probably never know exactly what occurred and most experts feel that no one is still around to tell us.

When the discovery was made that two of the plane's passengers were traveling on stolen passports they became immediate suspects in the plane's disappearance. Later we learned that many travelers fly using stolen passports and somehow get past security. You can be sure that everyone on the passenger list is going to undergo intense scrutiny. Some believe that China was the target of political factions opposed to Chinese interests since more than half the travelers were Chinese passengers. As details emerge it is clear that one or both pilots were most likely involved. My own theory is that more than one individual was responsible for rerouting the jetliner which departed at 12:41 AM from Kuala Lumpur, Indonesia. The

astrological chart for the departure time contains clues about existing conditions. I always look at the Moon when something happens in the public view. Here the Moon was in Gemini on the cusp of the 7<sup>th</sup> House of the public, open enemies, partners and collaborators in harsh aspect to Neptune (deception) on the cusp of the 4th House of foundations and base of operations. So the flight may have been scheduled to transport passengers, but the perpetrator (surely one of the pilots was in on this and experts are taking a hard look at a flight simulator for additional clues that one of the pilots had in his home and perhaps used to "practice" his maneuver) had other intentions that involved sabotage. With this aspect alone in key houses nothing is what it appears to be on the surface. The plot thickened before takeoff. It reminds me of espionage, the trickster, and hidden agendas. Venus in Aquarius on the cusp of the 3<sup>rd</sup> house of transportation and in the same degree as China's Ascendant directly opposed The Dark Moon Lilith on the cusp of the 9<sup>th</sup> House of foreign travel and grand ideas or noble thinking - you can also call this radical reasoning. Lilith in turn was in out-of-sign hard aspect to Mars, the Moon's North Node, and Vesta in Libra and Ceres in early Scorpio in the 11<sup>th</sup> House of goals, hopes and wishes, ideology and associations creating an upsetting pattern called a T-square that often goes hand-in-hand with activities linked to terrorism or extreme behavior patterns. Pluto in Capricorn opposed Jupiter in Cancer in the economic houses, 2 and 8 and both were in hard aspect to transiting Uranus in Aries in the chart's 5<sup>th</sup> House of risk taking suggesting a dramatic move erupted that sent a strong message to a power country. Finally, close to the Midheaven/10<sup>th</sup> House cusp Pallas in Leo opposed the Part of Fortune on the cusp of the 4<sup>th</sup> House of foundations - we want to hurt you in the pocketbook since we don't like your politics. Right now we have to cut everyone some slack - we don't know who did what. Stay tuned.

## **READERS CORNER**

Q. After experiencing a horrific long weekend with former neighbors and feeling the wrath of my angry husband I would like your take on how I can avoid a future encounter with guests who invited themselves. These neighbors moved away two years ago. We socialized with them occasionally through neighborhood events but had no special friendship. It was their custom while they lived here to attend an annual boat and recreation show and apparently they kept up the tradition after the move. When they called last month to ask if they could stay with us I said yes without giving their visit much thought because they told me they would be gone most of the weekend and would arrive on Friday and leave on Monday morning. Our two sons are in college so we have spare bedrooms. We did not discuss meals because I did not think they would be a factor. I advised them to arrive after 6 on Friday to allow me time to

get home from work and prepare a light snack for them. My husband was not very pleased when he learned that I had extended an invitation to the couple since we were not close friends and he was never a fan of the husband. I should have known when I pulled into my driveway that the weekend was off to a bad start when they were already parked outside at 4:45 PM. I left work early to make sure I was home before their arrival. When I realized they expected to be fed I wound up calling for pizza delivery and invited them to share it with us. My husband was not happy that they took it for granted that they would be welcome dinner guests. The next morning they were looking for breakfast so I provided bagels and muffins. Before they left for the boat show they asked what time I was serving dinner. Sure enough they were back early and hungry; ditto for breakfast and dinner on Sunday. In between they gave us the lowdown on the boat show, played with our kids' games and monopolized the family room TV even lobbied for the programming so they could keep up with their favorite shows. My husband said that I should have told them they were on their own for Sunday dinner but I did not want to make waves. I told them after breakfast on Sunday they had to leave on Monday morning at 7 when I left for work, and could have a bowl of cereal if they could get up early to eat it. How should I have handled this matter? My spouse (Aries) said he does not want them here as guests next year and does not appreciate the way they used us. He also told me he does not like the couple especially the husband (Capricorn) and thought they were cheapskates for not offering to host us for a meal or give us a gift since they did not pay for any lodging. He wanted to say something but I asked him not to make a scene. To make matters worse, while grocery shopping last week I saw another neighbor who knew the couple well and who would have been the logical hosts for this pair. I asked her if they had been in touch. She said they had not and recounted a similar story about how they invited themselves the previous year and that they wore out their welcome and would not be invited back. Help!

A. Thank you for writing. I had to condense your very detailed description of the visit and your guests' antics so we could look at the aspects between the men's planets. Interestingly enough you don't seem to have any harsh aspects with the woman's planets and could take it or leave it even though you have little in common with your old neighbor. The culprit in your own chart was Neptune on your Pisces Mercury so you were blindsided and misled by the request to stay in your home. The last eclipse also fell in your 4<sup>th</sup> House of home and family so there was a surprise element to the visit. The two spouses start with harsh aspects between their sun signs as Aries is not particularly friendly with Capricorn. Right now your husband has Uranus in Aries close to his Sun in square aspect to your visitor's Sun while Pluto in Capricorn in aspect to both charts is trending toward insisting on behavioral and attitude changes. Mercury in Pisces in harsh aspect to male neighbor's afflicted Mercury in Sagittarius suggests your spouse finds the other male to lack credibility. I hope your spouse cuts you some slack even though he was justifiably annoyed by the surprise element of the visit. Your biggest mistake was in not getting more details about the couple's expectations when they asked to stay in your home and in not stating how you would accommodate the visit. You were clearly caught off guard when the call came through. In the future why not let a caller know you will get back to them by a certain date while you sort out personal plans. After discussing such requests with your spouse you can determine whether you can minimally accommodate the guests and whether you wish to provide meals. If you know you cannot entertain visitors on a

certain date you can let them know up front without feeling guilty that the time will not work for you. Kudos for maintaining your cool!

- Q. I am 33, divorced and have been married once. Almost everyone I have ever dated is a person I met through work or has been a work colleague. Around this time last year I broke up with a partner that I met on the job. Last month I met someone new at a business conference my company hosted. We have been communicating mostly via text and e-mail and are going out for the first time in early April. I know that dating someone you work with is not always a good idea. Why do I have this tendency to meet all my partners through work? Is there something in my chart that drives it? I can remember only two people since high school that I did not meet in a work environment. I even dated my boss some years ago although he encouraged me to accept another job that opened up so there was no supervision conflict. Thank you for clarifying.
- A. You are a Leo with Moon, Mars and Mercury in Cancer. Your time of birth gives you Aquarius on the Ascendant and places those Cancer planets in your 6<sup>th</sup> House of work, daily environment, colleagues, and organization. Your Sun falls in the 7<sup>th</sup> House of partners along with your Moon's North Node, often an indicator that you meet up with and collaborate with very specific individuals so that your activity is in alignment with your Soul Path. Venus in Virgo falls in your 8<sup>th</sup> House of intimacy meaning that you have very definite ideas about how you wish to be loved, caressed and cherished.

Your astrology chart has twelve major segments called Houses. Planets that reside in these houses or rule the cusps (doors) of the houses describe the nature of your life's activities. Houses Five through Eight explore some of the relationships you are likely to encounter in this lifetime. We call this grouping the Zone of Intimacy. the Zone of Relationships, or The Soul Mate Zone. When the Moon resides in this sector, you experience firsthand how others affect your emotions. The Moon monitors and helps you balance your emotions. Work place dynamics highlight your astrology chart's Sixth House of employment, a key area of interest to you. Briefly, the Fifth House describes your social life, how you recreate, where you vacation, whom you date, your lovers and your affairs. Think of this house as an attraction-generating zone that lets you assess the potential of partners. In your chart, Mercury rules the 5<sup>th</sup> house but resides in the 6<sup>th</sup> of work so you have an abundance of work relationships. The Sixth House, the main focus for you because you have three planets there, describes your colleagues, co-workers, clients, contacts, service personnel, and the general nature of the employment scene. A wide range of settings explore relationships which evolve through work connections. Partnerships of all types fall in the Seventh House - marriage or business partners, roommates, significant others, advisors, consultants and the public. The Seventh House actually describes qualities you desire in a partner. For a view of sex and intimacy, look at the Eighth House for planets that describe your receptivity and compatibility to romantic and sensual relationships. As the relationship evolves, you'll get the big picture on whether you and your partner have magnetic chemistry or are destined for a brother-sister relationship.

Individuals with planets in these houses usually have a high degree of interaction with other people. When three or more planets fall in the Sixth House, the work setting often becomes the focal point of considerable social activity related to the job scene. You easily find best friends among coworkers, bosses, or contacts.

Be on the lookout for workaholics as well and avoid becoming one yourself. Placement of a combination of the personal planets, Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, and sometimes Jupiter in this house heighten the opportunity for work place romance - you have **three** of them. Larger organizations seem more open to employing bonded couples if there are no conflicts of interest along supervisory lines. Some companies are OK with hiring married couples but discourage pursuit of a hot romance on company time. Officials would rather see Mars and Venus do their thing on neutral turf. Embarrassing moments disrupt productivity. Employee discomfort mushrooms when they see coworkers sneaking a smooch in the hallway or necking in the parking lot after lunch. Think that doesn't happen much? Guess again.

With some of the intimate planets located in your Sixth House you are bound to form close ties with work contacts at sometime during your trek through the wonderful world of work. Be open to the possibilities. Potential dates are those very individuals who influence a part of your workday. Some common denominator binds you together whether you share adjoining space or provide a needed service for a client. Savor your good fortune when romance blossoms through your career connections. Your biggest bonus is yet to come. Just make sure you check with me to select the ideal wedding date. See you at the altar.
