Cyber-security breaches continue to make headlines and invade our space via news reports and in-boxes. Look how many stories are flooding the airwaves these days. Be sure to send every suspicious piece of mail to your SPAM folder without opening it. Readers have been complaining about receiving a rash of poorly conceived e-mail messages targeting political parties or specific individuals in these parties. The sender usually posts some type of introductory message pretending to wonder if the information is true but assuring the reader that it will "give you something to think about." That should be your clue to send the message to SPAM but if you read it since it came from a friend or relative, delete it anyway. Fear mongering SPAM is still making the rounds suggesting that something awful is going to happen to you unless you send the attachment on to 5, 10 or 15 friends. Resist the urge to argue with the sender but let the sender know you don't wish to receive this type of mail and ask to be removed from the mailing list; if the mail persists, block the individual from sending you more. Still another alert involves a notification with attachment that you are to appear in court; ignore it and send to SPAM.

BIRTHDAY HIGHLIGHTS FOR AQUARIUS

Happy Birthday, Aquarius! Yours is the sign of the Water Bearer, the personification of optimism and an air sign; fourth of the fixed signs of the Zodiac and the natural occupant of the 11th House of associations, friendships, goals, groups, your employer's resources, hopes, humanitarian endeavors, motivations, mutual organizations, new trends, unorthodox methods, wishes, and sudden revelations or change. Most people with 11th House emphasis in their chart know an astrologer or two and keep their phone numbers

handy. Your colors are brilliant or electric blues, indigo, most medium blue shades, sky blue, ultramarine and accents of bright white. Yours is prominent among analytical sun signs giving you a leg up on problem solving with your inventive style and skill for improving relationships on the local or world stage. Aquarius, your birthday year starts off with Jupiter in Leo through August 11 which activates your solar 7th House of marriage, relationships, partners and the public giving you access to a new mix of people, a variety of roommates, collaborators and many interesting if not unpredictable encounters. Single Aquarians may meet the love of your life; if already committed you may decide to marry or become engaged. You won't be short on company and many of you will have to decide whether new or existing people have the level of sincerity you desire; some will go through a test while others head to the altar. Jupiter is about expansion of resources, so follow your dream. When Jupiter heads for Virgo on August 11 you will be taking a look at housing options, your debts and investments, partnership or joint finances and releasing of burdens you don't think you deserve. The retrograde period in Scorpio means you have a bit more work to do on major goals, personal relationships and in dealing with parents, authority figures or older relatives. No doubt you have seen a change in responsibilities after tweaking your mission and finishing up old business, Uranus your ruling planet is in Aries all year and stays in your solar 3rd House of communication, education, transportation, mental state, siblings or cousins, technological equipment and local neighborhoods while especially influencing those born February 1-11. benefits of a Neptune transit. The period calls for a close look at priorities as well as checking financial and credit reports. From a career standpoint you will have a chance to tap into your spiritual outlook or philosophy as you engage in meaningful work. Be sure to listen o your feelings. Entrepreneurs of start-up businesses blossom under these aspects if part of your goal structure. Pluto in Capricorn in your solar 12th House of self-healing, introspection, quiet reflection, seclusion, private thoughts, behind-the scenes- activity, visiting the sick, widows, orphans, secret enemies, and self-assessment most affects those of you born February 2-7 through the rest of your 2015 birthday cycle. Uranus in your solar 3rd House could clash with this Pluto placement before mid-summer and it does present a bit of a challenge during the year reminding you keep your cherished goals in mind. Pluto in this section awakens your subconscious, influences dreams and their meanings; some of you could feel much more psychic than usual. Play your hunches - they proved right in the past and could shed light on emerging issues. Revelations come to light and change the picture you had of everyday reality - whether connected with your work, health, relationships and philosophy. No doubt you have some critical decisions to make regarding your career, ambition, status and lifestyle since this house is also prominent again during 2015 when Saturn returns for a brief stay in Scorpio. The first supercharged New Moon solar eclipse of 2015 takes place on March 20 in the last degree of Pisces in your solar 2nd House of personal income and resources. You could be making plans to spend some of your hard-earned cash on a long-standing goal. You'll have to trust your gut on this one after looking at all the angles, especially with the Sun in Pisces right on this degree on the 20th. Two weeks later you experience the first Lunar Eclipse, also supercharged in Libra moving through your solar 9th House of travel on April 4th. You can head for distant spaces, sign up for career-enhancing training, resume tweaking for a coveted assignment, and see your words in print via publishing opportunities that bring your emerging talent to the forefront. Another of those supercharged new moons like the one that takes place on September 13th occurs when the second solar eclipse of 2015 falls in Virgo in your solar 8th House of joint finances, agreements, intimacy, releasing of ties that bind or suffocate energy, (such as burdens that are not really yours, a difficult job, another's financial debt, or painful emotional burdens). Be sure to examine important paperwork, joint agreements, loan documents and the solvency of partnerships. The last eclipse of 2015 takes place on September 27 in Aries. This one is a total lunar

eclipse in your 3rd house of communication, community events, neighbors, transportation, electronic equipment, education and siblings. Many of you will hear about moves, contracts, conversations, and thought-provoking communication and may even take part in some of the related dynamics. Your solar 3rd House has been hot and heavy over the last few years so one last hurrah is part of the wallpaper. Challenges occur to blend the best of your work and home life for ultimate enjoyment. Make your ideas count. With Uranus in this house along with the eclipse vibes you can count on twists and turns in communication and in getting to the bottom of puzzling situations. Enjoy new opportunities that come your way and share your energy and expertise in ways that make this an exciting time period. Then you can welcome the changes that bring you abundant happiness.

PLANETS PLACES FROM JANUARY 20-FEBRUARY 18

Several planetary conditions are prominent in this cycle. For starters Mercury goes retrograde in Aquarius for three weeks starting January at 10:54 AM EST and goes direct on February 11. I know, I know, some of you have been telling me that you already feel like the planet of communication and transportation is already retrograde with vehicle malfunctions, lost checks, holds placed on your finances, confusion over insurance policies and stolen credit cards. Be sure to check all information you share and don't rush in to signing documents. Take time to read that new book, catch up on correspondence, work on a pending project, clean out closets and research your next iob. All of the retrograde Mercury periods occur in air signs in 2015. Venus starts out in Aquarius and moves into Pisces during this period; and Mars occupies Pisces the entire month lending an air of compassion and romance to social and creative settings. Right after the Sun moves to Aquarius on the 20th we have the new Moon in this sign at 8:14 AM, so don't forget to write your Law of abundance checks within 24-hours of the New Moon and jot down goals that are meaningful for you. Jupiter is retrograde in Leo and gives clues to some Leos born around August 9-11 to pay attention to health, work and diet during this period. Some of you have some financial matters to take care of so see your advisor for better insight. Saturn is in Sagittarius now and most affects those of you born November 22-25 in this cycle as well as members of fire signs born 3/20-24, 7/23-26 and opposes the suns of Geminis born 5/22-25. Dynamics occur that affect the Sun, Saturn, Uranus and Pallas that call for resolution of intense problems; some facet of technology may be involved on a large scale. These aspects linger for the rest of January and with Pallas and Mars and then Chiron in the mix, we can hear about warfare, sudden attacks, and unsettling threats to security.

Uranus in Aries and Pluto in Capricorn are in harsh aspect to each other for the next 4-5 months so if you have planets at the 11th -13th degrees of cardinal signs, please note the house placement of these transits. Be cautious of communication that can be misconstrued and risks involving financial documents that could be incomplete or mistake-laden. The planet Neptune (in Pisces until 2026) drives inspirational, spiritual and trust issues now and most affects Pisces born February 24-26. Chiron is direct in Pisces and most affects those born March 4-6 providing a major awakening of consciousness, a long-sought healing opportunity and the insight to face the facts about what your fears are doing to your life. Once you overcome your fear you get to experience and welcome success. If you were born with Chiron in Pisces check the house where it resides because this month could be a real eye opener giving you a long-sought solution to the place where you are stuck. All readers should check the house where Mars in Pisces is visiting throughout February to better understand stress factors present in your life.

With the Moon in Sagittarius on Valentine's Day and Venus and Mars in harsh aspect, don't be surprised to hear of a few lovers' quarrels; avoid them yourself if you can; and look for ways to share favorite pastimes or a meal with your Sweetheart. Make decisions based on the house in your natal chart where Uranus is moving. Pluto is in Capricorn all month and affects Cardinal sign people born at 11-13 degrees of your sign: Capricorn, Aries, Cancer or Libra. These degrees are making close contact with Uranus. This aspect goes on for several months, so watch your health and pay attention to safety matters especially with Pluto in the mix affecting the house where you have had a recent Aries eclipse. Look for ways to improve your social life and financial health and seek the counsel of business experts and trusted advisors based on your particular circumstances.

PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

With awards' season in full swing through the end of February I am receiving mail asking about prominent nominees. Some of the individuals listed below have received Golden Globes and Critics' Choice awards. All have been nominated for an Oscar; some of their movies have also been nominated for the coveted best picture award. The Oscar awards show will air on February 22. Readers also ask about political figures making the news especially those who are hinting at throwing their hat in the ring to run for President next year.

Celebrity Standouts: The four nominees listed here are comprised of two Capricorns, one Virgo, and one Sagittarius, so the earth signs have the edge in this small sample.

Julianne Moore: It seems this is Julianne's year - she has won several awards so far - both the Golden Globes and Critics' Choice award for best leading actress for her portrayal of an Alzheimer's patient in STILL ALICE. Julianne is a Sagittarius born December 3 with a stellium of Capricorn planets and her Sun opposing her Moon in Gemini. Eddie Redmayne, a Capricorn born January 6 with a large stellium of Sagittarius and Libra planets and the Moon in Taurus won a Golden Globe award for his portrayal of physicist Stephen Hawking in THE THEORY OF EVERYTHING. Michael Keaton, a Virgo born on September 5 won the Golden Globes Award for best actor in a Comedy or Musical for his role in BIRDMAN as well as a Critics' Choice Award for best actor. Bradley Cooper has received his 4th Oscar nomination for his role in AMERICAN SNIPER. Bradley, who is a Capricorn born January 5, has a stellium of Capricorn and Libra planets, and his chart has received numerous hits from the high impact Aries and Libra eclipses as well as the interplay of Uranus in Aries and Pluto in Capricorn in hard aspect to many houses and planets in his chart. How do you think these stars will fare in the Oscar awards? Stay tuned!

I am not surprised that many of you want information about the possible candidates who plan to run for President. Very few are actually admitting they have plans but they have dropped hints and you have asked me about those who seem eager to seek the nomination of their respective parties. Recall my earlier newsletters for the last several elections that talk about the need for a candidate to have a strong chart alliance with the Aquarius Moon in the U.S. chart. Remember that the Moon represents the pulse of the nation's citizens, their interests and how the nation will view their candidacy. No matter what you think today, if the connection does not hold out, the candidate does not win the election. If there is no connection to begin with, nothing will bring in the win. In my years of researching the elections I have not seen it happen. Some of the candidates have charts with progressions and transits that seem to be leaning toward taking on less rather than more responsibility even though it may not seem like what they are planning today. Can you guess which ones? I believe that both parties will have other candidates in the running than those I have listed below. In a nutshell, here is what I see at this writing.

Mitt Romney: The former candidate, a Pisces, is said to be interested in another run for the highest office. Last election he had some temporary transits that put him in the limelight yet as the campaign went on the transits waned and so did his chances of winning the election. His natal chart does not have planets at 25 degrees.

Marco Rubio: This eager to make a difference candidate is a Gemini born in Miami and the youngest person to hint at entering the ring so far. While he does have some Aquarius placements in his chart none are close enough to the U.S. Moon in Aquarius. Even if he gets the support of his party, he probably will not win.

Chris Christie: The governor of New Jersey is a Virgo born September 6. He has no Aquarius planets close to 25-26 degrees and the few placements in late degrees of air signs that he has would not be effective in this type of political race.

Jeb Bush: Of the Republican candidates his Sun in Aquarius comes close but not close enough to the U.S. Moon to bring in the win. Like Mitt Romney, he will have some progressed planets at 25 degrees that get him into the leading candidate limelight; his progressed Sun in Aries is now at that degree and his progressed

Midheaven at 25 degrees of Leo. By the time the next round of progressions occurs in 2016, they will have moved away from the 25 degree hit and do not appear to be of value down the road.

Hillary Clinton: Yes, Hillary, a Scorpio born October 26 has that magic 25 degree connection with her Uranus in Gemini in a perfect trine to the U.S. Moon in Aquarius. As far as I know she has not declared herself to be in the running even though the public says she's going for it. Her natal chart will undergo several transformations over the next year and may affect her priorities; she will be very popular with the voters and will surely change her campaign strategy. The transit of Jupiter over her Leo planets lends support especially through next spring. We will just have to wait and see what happens.

READERS CORNER

As we approach February, traditionally known as the month of love an influx of questions about romance came in including questions about the staying power of relationships, blossoming love, and break-ups. Some questions have come from readers of my articles on romance featured at several websites including Star IQ and Astral Hearts. Here are a few.

- Q. I started dating a woman in mid-December that I met at a holiday party. We have gone out four times and I would like to keep seeing her; the feeling seems to be mutual. As Valentine's Day approaches I would like to give her a gift but nothing that is too personal since we have not been a couple for very long. I would take her to dinner but I will be traveling for two weeks and will not return home until the 19th. Does Sun sign matter? She is an Aries and I am a Leo. Thank you for your assistance.
- A. Since you haven't dated for any length of time how about tying a gift to a hobby or interest of hers. You could send her a gift card for downloadable music or reading material, personalized office supplies, entertainment or food items, maybe even a gift card to a favorite restaurant. You might also send a small box of candy if flowers seem too romantic for you at this stage. Write a personal note if possible. Sun signs do not matter in this case even though your fire signs are in sync; the longevity of your relationship and what you know about your friend drive the type of gift that is most appropriate.
- Q. We are 8 women who started our careers at the same company and although we have all moved on, we make it a point go out for brunch the first Saturday or Sunday after the New Year. One of the women (Taurus) and I had the same boss who still invites us to an annual holiday party. She attended the party without her spouse (he usually attended every year) and confided in me that they had separated in October and were headed for divorce. She told the women at the annual brunch about her separation but provided no details. An attendee sitting across from me at the meal shot me a glance and mouthed, "Did you know?" I nodded discreetly but said nothing else. Later that evening this inquisitive woman (Sagittarius) called to probe for details and I told her I had none. She suggested I call our friend to find out what happened and ask if she needed to talk to someone. I was annoyed and did not call. A few days later she called again to see if I had any new information and I told her I did not get around to calling. I feel if my friend wanted to discuss the matter she would do so.

What is going on astrologically that puts me in the middle of this curiosity? I am a Gemini born May 24. I don't think I am going to answer the phone if the Sagittarius calls again.

A. Start by taking yourself right out of the middle, a place where you clearly don't belong. All three of you have birthdays at the early part of your signs. Your separated friend had one direct and one opposition hit to her Sun from eclipses in April and October of 2014, often a condition that brings about drastic life changes. Saturn just moved to Sagittarius on December 24 and is right on the Sun of the curious Sagittarius whose Sun opposes your Gemini birthday, sometimes a position of conflict where the parties do not see eye-to-eye. Ironically, Mercury (the communicator planet) in your chart falls on the Sun of your Taurus friend so she gave you the scoop first. You are correct in surmising that if your friend wanted to discuss her new status she would have done so away from any social gathering. You owe the curious colleague no explanation. Perhaps if you had told her the night she called that you would not be calling the Taurus for details she might have left it alone. If she calls again let her know that you do not see it as your place to probe for details. At some point you might call the Taurus just to see how she is doing but don't ask questions. You seem to have good judgment regarding boundaries and your friend will appreciate your discretion.

Q. I have been dating a wonderful woman for nearly two years. Just as things began to get serious between us she announced in October that she was changing careers and left a 10-year corporate job with occasional travel for a position in the travel industry. The new career requires travel for more than half the year and could include some holidays. She took a month of leave in November and plunged right into her new work which took her out of the country for 3 weeks. She is away now and will be gone for 25 days. I am not happy with the new arrangements and do not feel she told me enough about the scope of her responsibilities before taking the position. She says that she gets a month off each year and thinks that is a generous amount of vacation. I feel she went into this venture blindly and that it is going to leave us in a disastrous or unfulfilling place. I was shopping for a ring but now it seems like a waste of time. What is going to happen to our relationship? We are both Aquarians. What do you see in our charts?

A. Only the two of you can decide what is going to happen with the relationship. Your partner is a double Aquarius born with her Sun rising in the 1st House and her Leo Moon on the cusp of her 7th House of partnerships. That said her chart has been bombarded with eclipses in key houses for the last 2-1/2 years, so I doubt she was happy in her old job especially in the past year of employment. She has Scorpio on the cusp of the 10th House of career which received two eclipse hits in 2014; and her 4th House of home received the same two hits, one by conjunction and the other by opposition to the cusp degrees. (It would be very difficult to stay in the same job with all that is going on with her.) In 2013, these alignments were moving into place which would make her restless and eager to find more satisfaction in her work life. All four angles of her chart had activity. Not only were the angles active but so were her 9th House of long-distance travel and her 3rd house of education and travel and transportation, both of which had eclipses (and still do) going through them. Something had to give and it did. And look where she went career-wise!
