GEMINI and THE YEAR AHEAD

Happy Birthday, Gemini! Your Sun Sign rules the hands, arms and shoulders in the communication-oriented 3rd House of brothers, sisters, cousins and other relatives as well as neighbors, classes, communities, education, transportation (all forms including purchasing and repairing of vehicles), media interests and networks, (phones, computers, faxes, Internet, social networks), writing and the diverse facets of your mind, especially how it works and the impact on your mental state. The 3rd house is ruled by Mercury and Gemini's symbol is the Twins making you both an air sign and a mutable sign. This combination helps you in your role as a conversationalist and an analyst who questions relationships with people, objects and ideas. Your quick yet changeable mind takes in an abundance of information, some of which you retain and much of which you discard after the reason for retention subsides. You excel at examining as many sides of a situation as possible. If the premise is boring and exhausting, you bail and head for a lively party to recharge your batteries. You share your ruling planet Mercury, with Virgo. This year the Sun enters your sign on May 21 at 4:45 AM EDT and leaves on June 21 at 12:38 PM EDT. **Jupiter in Leo** is wrapping up a trip through your solar 3rd house of education, mental prowess, clever solutions, cousins, siblings, media interests, all forms of communication and transportation, local travel, community and your neighbors, coursework and writing or the general transmission of messages. While in Leo you have had opportunities to get involved in your community, to enroll in classes that strengthen your competitiveness for future work, peak your interest in creative topics, and lead to overall life satisfaction. Some of you may have had more frequent contact or visits from siblings and other relatives. If you are shopping for a new car or home do your homework but delay buying these big ticket items while Mercury is retrograde from May 18 through June 11. By August 11 **Jupiter enters Virgo** where it remains until September 10, 2016 in your 4th House of home, family, stability, base of operation, relatives, especially parents. For many of you this location of Jupiter means your house could undergo redecoration, remodeling and repairs of all types; maybe you just want a new look in some of the rooms. Others find it necessary to make repairs after storms or the normal cycle of wear and tear. Keep in touch with advisors, accountants and attorneys if you have important documents to sign. You also have the long passage this year of **Venus in Leo** in this 3rd house so good things can happen in the romance department; action centers on products you promote, or you undertake new ventures including starting a home-based business; some will add family or long-term guests to the home. The Venus dates are June 5-July 18 and again from August 1-October 8. **Saturn is retrograde in Sagittarius at 1° now and has been stirring things up in your solar 7th House of partners since December 24.** This house covers both business and intimate partnerships including spouses, roommates, significant others, personal relationships, advisors, legal and medical professionals and collaborators. When Saturn lands in the 7th you often meet a partner with a significant age difference; you could also see the serious side of a relationship as a steady, good thing and opt for a marriage. If a current relationship has been troublesome you either put

solid time into repairing it or part ways. I have seen individuals with this transit meet someone who lives across the country and do everything possible to get the relationship to work; some will find the stress too much and will give up or decide to move to pursue the relationship in another city; many tie the knot. **On June 15th Saturn returns to Scorpio to play a leading role in your 6th House of work, daily environment, set routines, health, pets, co-workers and business connections, nutrition, and levels of fitness where it remains until September 17 before taking up a two-year plus run in Sagittarius again.** Geminis who are born the last three days of Gemini have a strong Saturn connection during this period as it highlights your work and health habits. Both your job and your physical welfare, and your nerves meet the challenges that come up. Whatever you have left over from last fall comes up for final settlement so you can sort through and discard unwanted burdens, possibly a job. Saturn also helps get rid of your bad habits. **Mars in Gemini is racing through your natal sign in your solar 1st House adding energy and passion to your prominent undertakings. If you are thinking of a personal makeover, a new hair style or implementation of new procedures, this is the time to act.** Avoid impulsiveness especially during the Mercury retrograde period from May 18-June 11. **Uranus in Aries most affects those of you born June 3-13** while it travels through your Solar 11th House all year. That is the house of friendships and associations. Pluto is at home in the 8th house, its natural habitat so the lessons are long and deep, in fact Pluto makes a stressful aspect called the inconjunct or quincunx this year if you are born on

the dates listed above. Evaluation of the status quo is necessary so that both intimate and business matters, especially financial ones, are dealt with honestly and you find the tools to purge what you no longer need. Pluto is still clashing with transiting Uranus in Aries in your solar 11th House of goals and associates. You have your work cut out for you when Pluto highlights those sticky issues you wish would go away. Pluto is here to remind you of your vulnerability so that you can prepare and develop a strategy for success. While unexpected expenses, income adjustments, and financial cutbacks could be part of the picture, so is learning the truth about relationships, intimacy, and what you are mulling over deep inside. The first two eclipses that affect you in 2015 have already occurred. The first fell on March 20, a solar eclipse in Pisces in your 10th House of career and status. This new moon suggests that you are going to experience a new beginning in some facet of your job, career, sense of responsibility or status in life. You could experience a breakthrough in awareness or consciousness and actually want to listen to the voice within to determine next steps. Some of you may meet influential people who serve as catalysts for the changes that are in the wind. You could be seeking more information and fielding data on an intuitive level. All you have to do is ask for advice when you are ready to turn the page and look at new approaches. **The second eclipse of the year is a full moon eclipse that fell on April 4 in Libra and has influence on your solar 5th House of romance, play time, recreation, social life and children through September 27 and beyond.** If you aren't already in a relationship, many of you will be looking for one and some will play the field, unable to make a decision or even desire a permanent partner. Look out Match.Com, OK Cupid, Zoosk, eHarmony and Our Time - Gemini is a social animal and will be checking out the prospects. Even if you are just looking for a friend, you won't have any trouble linking up with some witty conversationalists at parties and summer picnics. **When the next solar eclipse hits, it will activate your solar 4th House of home, foundation, family and base of operation on September 13 in Virgo.** If you are a Gemini (or have a Gemini Ascendant) you could get downright serious about putting your home on the market or accepting a job in another state or country. This eclipse will call attention to all types of domestic matters - harmony or tension in the home; news of a family birth or death; members returning or leaving your home; remodeling and landscaping projects; reinforcing your home's foundation in some manner; and entertaining at home base or including your extended family in vacation plans. This eclipse influences your chart until March 2016. **Certain Geminis experience significant activity in the 11th House of associates, professional organizations, groups, and goals when the September 27 eclipse in Aries occurs near transiting Uranus in Aries.** It could mean that a whirlwind of activity includes unexpected offers, romantic attraction, invitations to new venues or sudden events that lead to a change in plans. Dynamics may involve a new love interest or an affiliate with whom you share a dream or philosophy. Aries is a passionate sign so don't be surprised if you attend your high school reunion and find that someone you knew long ago is single like you, finds you attractive and wants to hold your hand rather than sit on the sidelines. This eclipse could also trigger some

unfinished business from the April 4 eclipse in your solar 5th House and you either get serious about a prospective partner or you leave the relationship behind once you figure out the partnership lacks substance. Many of you accept or are asked to take on new leadership responsibilities in a club, group or organization. At any rate the year should bring you in contact with new people and exciting contacts. Do what you love - accept those invitations and share dreams with kindred spirits. Embrace this cycle of eclipses to enjoy the new beginnings that are part of your birthday cycle. May 21-JUNE 21 PLANET ACTIVITY

Tension and Tenacity: As we start the Gemini cycle, **Saturn is retrograde in motion hanging on to the 1st degree of Sagittarius** as it makes its way back to Scorpio on June 15. Those of you born the first couple of days of Gemini, Sagittarius, Pisces and Virgo are most affected now and will take on additional responsibility or put a new perspective on issues where you want closure but need more information. When Saturn returns to Scorpio it will mostly affect you if born the last three degrees of Scorpio, Taurus, Leo or Aquarius. Patience and determination pay off grandly but be sure to keep your cool. **Mercury just turned retrograde on May 18 in Gemini** and will resume direct motion on June 11. These two days are called station days and call for caution in travel and finalizing commitments or legal matters. Be alert on the road and in project transactions or purchases and double check estimates. **Venus in Cancer** releases emotional moods and affection through June 5 and then **moves to Leo** with its playful and romantic air for the rest of the Gemini Sun cycle. **Mars is on a rapid trip through Gemini in your solar 1st House** during the next month so you should have plenty of energy to tackle projects, start an exercise program or intensify the pace of developing relationships. Keep cool under fire if you encounter stressful situations and edgy people. All the good will you build up can go down the drain if you cross hairs with major players in your field of action. **Jupiter in Leo covers 15-19 degrees of the sign this month and most affects those of you born August 8-13; Jupiter favorably aspects Sagittarius born December 7-11 and Aries born April 5-9 while challenging the other fixed signs Taurus, Scorpio and Aquarius.** Jupiter works best after June 11 if you are considering the purchase of any big ticket items, sale of your home or purchase of a new car. Sign important papers or deal with legal matters after checking with your astrologer to determine favorable dates. Sometimes Jupiter is a major player in health matters including selecting dates for surgery and medical tests. **Uranus in Aries travels at 18-19 degrees** in harsh aspect to Pluto in Capricorn; those born under the signs Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn or with planets at the

18th through 19th degree could see important matters surface or find that major life changes emerge in the next several weeks - the aspect plays out all year especially due to retrograde activity of these planets - you'll know what it is but you won't be able to solve it all at once. Right now Uranus is one of the main triggers in the deadly earthquakes, horrific tornados, fires, train crashes and developing warfare that are wreaking havoc in the US and abroad.

As we move into the early days of Gemini the planets making hard aspects include the Sun in relationship to transiting Pluto and Venus opposing Pluto - configurations that highlight the themes of personal and global security, financial integrity including the solvency of retirement funds; mergers and the merit of implementing them; and money lending or pooling. As we move closer to the end of the month and into early June Venus squares Uranus and pugilist Mars squares Neptune so underdog factions and women's rights face lack of support or understanding; themes related to LGBT issues surface in parts of the nation; connections between Vesta (focus) and Pallas (change agent) heat up and call attention to weak links in upward mobility and compensation. Tempers are likely to flare when you have any planet in hard aspect to transiting Mars; even if you keep your emotions in check you could find yoga or deep breathing a helpful antidote to a churning stomach. **Neptune in Pisces goes retrograde on June 12 right around the time that Mercury goes direct - expect mixed signals in the romance department. This planet conjoins the Suns of Pisces born February 27-March 1 and gives you opportunities to use creative imagination in executing future plans.** If you change your health care plan, a treatment method or start a new medication, be sure you are alert to any side effects or reactions and check back with your physician. Allergies surface even if they were never a major irritant in the past. **Pluto in retrograde motion during this cycle moves slowly in Capricorn on the Sun of members born at the 15th and 14th degrees of the sign, approximately January 7-5** - the message during this period is to give some thought to how you are going to solve current problems or offer advice to those who depend on you for support. Hidden information may come to light that affects pending matters. Diplomacy helps. Even though you may not feel like waiting until a better time, make lemonade while you wait for the green light. Gather information related to implementing desired goals; call on specialists or advisors. Similar information applies to other members of cardinal signs, **Aries, Cancer and Libra with planets at 15-14 degrees.** From a global standpoint the energy remains volatile while we wait for declarations and disclosures of a political and financial nature. Chiron in Pisces is direct at 21 degrees although it will go retrograde on this degree June 25 just after as we enter the sign Cancer. Expect painful memories or exchanges especially for Pisces born around the 10th - 12th of March. Release that pain and confront the truth about anyone who is sandbagging or giving you the runaround. Cathartic release works best; check with your advisor if you need more options. You'll be ready for a summer adventure and unusual reunions.

Princess Charlotte Elizabeth Diana of Cambridge: The daughter of Prince William and the Duchess of Cambridge was born on May 2. This bundle of joy carries the names of her Great-Grandmother, Queen Elizabeth and her paternal Grandmother, Diana, the Princess of Wales. Her chart has numerous connections between her parents, most notable that her Ascendant is Cancer and both parents are born with the Moon in Cancer on her Ascendant. Not only is that connection strong but her chart shows that her father is a water sign (William is a Cancer) and her mother, an earth sign (Kate is a Capricorn). Diana's Cancer sun falls near Charlotte's Ascendant and her Great-Grandmother's Leo Moon falls on Charlotte's Juno/Jupiter conjunction in Leo in the 3rd House of communication and education. Both share a Taurus Sun Sign. What will we learn over time as this little one grows up and blossoms? Stay tuned.

Bruce Jenner: This former Olympian and current co-star of **Keeping Up With The Kardashians** is making headlines these days as he undertakes the difficult journey of transitioning to a female. His widely-viewed interview with Diane Sawyer opened the doors for understanding more about the complex process of Transgender identification where the state of an individual's gender identity may not match the compatibility of their assigned sex. Readers want to know if he is serious about taking the plunge to undergo gender reassignment surgery and what is going on in his chart. Only Bruce can answer that question - no surgery dates have yet been announced. He is a double Scorpio (Sun and Ascendant in the sign). True to his sun sign, one of the most secretive in the Zodiac, he has kept much of his inner thoughts, feelings and identity a secret for most of his 65 years. Further emphasizing his complex turmoil, he has a loaded 12th House, also known as the house of secrets, reflection, and behind-the-scenes planning, filled with a stellium of Libra planets that end with Ceres (mother goddess of nurturing) in Libra in out of sign conjunction to his Scorpio Ascendant. My take on his chart is that during the past couple of years the intense placement of eclipses in his 12th and 6th Houses (he has the Moon's North Node in Aries conjunct the Dark Moon Lilith) made it too uncomfortable to stay silent and live with bottled emotional and psychological pain. Pluto hit natal Vesta (focus) over the last two years as well and he came to grips with his decision to go public and to engage

more fully in his desire to be a woman. I am sure we will find out when Bruce takes critical steps on the next leg of his journey and we wish him well.

The City of Baltimore: questions have come in regarding the Sun sign of this city that has come under siege after the April 12th death of prisoner Freddy Gray. Tension continued to build while Freddy's death was investigated leading to riots and rage that caused considerable destruction to the city and to an area of the city where residents had a lot to lose in terms of neighborhood amenities that were already scarce. The charter date for Baltimore was August 10, 1729 making it a Leo city with the Moon in Pisces. The city's chart depicts abundant duality with planetary clusters in the mutable signs Sagittarius, Pisces and Gemini meaning that tension is always ready to rise when conditions occur that strain the relationship of prosperous citizens versus the impoverished. Baltimore has a history of division and civil unrest - think the Civil War (placed under martial law due to the polarizing sympathies of residents divided by the war between the North and South) and the 1968 riots that occurred after the death of Dr. Martin Luther King. The city's natal Mars in Cancer, the planet of war and hostility was active in April engaged in a tense relationship with transiting Uranus (chaos, upheaval). Baltimore's natal Moon in Pisces is conjunct Saturn and both came under fire while transiting Neptune in Pisces was moving over them during April and on through the peak of the destruction. This Neptune transit seems to have created mixed messages about what happened to Freddie and escalated the emotional trauma and confusion that triggered violence and the need for a curfew and the protection of the National Guard. Ironically transiting Mars was in Taurus when Freddie was arrested at almost the same degree as it was during the riots in 1968. Mars was making a hard aspect to the city's natal Pluto in Libra. With the other prevailing aspects it is not surprising that leaders in Baltimore will look for ways to restructure the city's consciousness and look for critical solutions to conflict.

Matthew Weiner, the director, producer and primary writer for the hit TV series, Mad Men, is a double Cancer born June 29 in Baltimore with the literary sign Gemini showcasing Jupiter and the Moon's North Node. His chart also shows Mercury and Venus conjunct in Cancer - vivid images and solid depiction - Saturn and Chiron in Pisces - the allure of glamour and illusion to sell a product and attain wealth and power that played out in this acclaimed dramedy; and Uranus on Pluto in Virgo to go behind the scenes and unmask the deceptions, find the baggage and highlight the cultural themes of the day. This man can write and thoroughly research or put his team on areas of great interest, including the time period that defines the 1960s and exposes the flaws and sexism in the world of advertising prominent in that era. Mad Men was not an easy sell for TV and Weiner had it on the shelf for years before it aired and became a hit show with its impeccable acting and a cast of actors intricately involved to reveal the complex story and secrets of Don Draper. We'll miss you, Mad Men. Every episode had hidden treasures. Let's visualize the Emmy Award season generously recognizing your quality performances. (Cast reviewed in previously developed newsletters.)

READERS' CORNER

Thank you for the many questions and comments you sent during the past month. Your responsiveness to the Soul Mate material was overwhelming and I will include some of your related questions in future newsletters. Others responded to the

relocation material and indicated they learned a lot of new information about selecting compatible living areas. The question from the woman collecting for a charity on company time received additional comments: “I think she should apologize to the staff for bothering them”; “everybody gets hit up for donations on the job - just say no if you don’t want to contribute”; “the boss is too rigid and should just accept her apology and get on with the work”; “does she feel she is going to be fired?; if so start looking for a new job.” A couple of readers asked questions that actually called for full personal readings and updates; this column is not the venue for extensive personal analysis. Here are this month’s concerns; two of them discuss wardrobes.

Q. A friend invited me to lunch at her home and afterward showed me a custom closet she had designed for her bedroom. She actually had twin closets installed but only opened one. I was surprised to find a wall and a half devoted to blouses/shirts, many of which still had price tags on them; and built-in storage to hold her sweaters in the shelves above them. The other half had pants and jeans all carefully color-coordinated and I saw tags on many of them as well. Why do you think she is storing clothes in the closet without removing the tags? Do you see anything in her chart that explains why she would do this? Is she a hoarder?

A. I am very familiar with this scenario and have previously talked with clients and acquaintances that purchased clothing and stored items without removing the tags. Your friend is a Gemini with Moon in Capricorn and Mercury on Venus in hard aspect to Mars. Gemini likes variety and often will buy the same item in more than one color once they like a style.
