The year 2015 has four eclipses that affect you through September 2015 and two more that affect you in 2016 up to your birthday cycle. The influence of eclipses can last up to 12 months and can begin to show evolving conditions even before they actually occur. A partial solar eclipse that affects you personally and puts the spotlight on you takes place on September 13 in Virgo in your solar 1st House and stays the course until March 9 when another solar eclipse occurs in Pisces. This September 13 eclipse gives you a chance to speak your mind, initiate physical or professional change and call the shots on important areas in your life. Do you thrive on innovation? ## PLANETS POSITIONS AUGUST 23-SEPTEMBER 23

The big news during Virgo's cycle is the presence of the second solar eclipse of the year on September 13 in Virgo. Those of you born around that date can expect major movement over the next 6 months to a year - many of you are already feeling the vibes and have inkling about where major shifts will occur. Make major decisions in the week following the eclipse. The more distant outer planets are retrograde during this cycle and so is Chiron in Pisces. Conditions through the end of the month are more optimistic than they have been all summer. With Venus and Mars in Leo, romance could be in the wind for many who are enjoying Cupid's arrows, yet it will be no surprise to learn of high profile scandals involving affairs or a surprise divorce from a solid couple. The impact of the Uranus-Pluto square and the Aries-Libra eclipses continue to shake up the status quo through next year.

Jupiter in Vigo brings new opportunities for an expansive cycle in the house where it appears in your chart through September 10, 2016 when it moves to Libra and stimulates partnership ventures. In the meantime, you get a boost of attention and build confidence in the house where Jupiter falls in your natal chart; ditto for other early born earth signs, Taurus and Capricorn, You may decide to be of service to those less fortunate, improve your health or amp up the quality of your daily work. Certain Virgos will fund a new kitchen. Venus is retrograde in Leo until September 7 when it goes direct and stays in Leo during the rest of the month. It is traveling with Mars in Leo through the 24th and could accelerate activity in your recreational and social life. It is time to clean up the past when Mercury enters Libra on August 28 and goes retrograde on September 17 until October 9. A considerable amount of flip-flopping takes place in the week before the retrograde occurs - in politics, especially in the polls; in the workplace and in your personal life. Communication and equipment matters flare up September 15-23 so be sure to back up your data and update security software. Ceres is retrograde in late Capricorn until September 16 and opposes the U.S. Pluto in Capricorn; bashing of women or denying funding that will help them is part of the distressing energy that prevails. This position shows the need to make solid decisions regarding family matters, immigration and laws in need of reform. Watch the agenda of future political debates for emerging issues and the line of authority behind them. The Moon wobbles during the time preceding the September 13 eclipse lend confusion and backpedaling to candidates' platforms. Subversive dealings continue in the Middle East. Saturn completes its 29 year cycle in Scorpio on September 17 and moves into Sagittarius where it remains until late 2017. Right now it affects Scorpios born with the Sun at 28-30 degrees and moves on to affect Sagittarius born November 22-23. Early Aries and Leo Suns enjoy the gifts from the sign shift during the second half of September. Those with the conjunction benefit from a close look at financial and legal papers, a medical checkup, eye examination or dental work; late water signs experience smooth transactions in making major purchases before September 17 and positive changes in the daily work environment. The fixed signs Taurus and Leo may be taking a critical look at current life conditions to make sure anticipated plans go smoothly. Retrograde Uranus in Aries visits the Sun of those born April 8-10 when it covers 20 and 19 degrees of Aries. Readers should check your chart for planets in those degrees which call attention to unplanned activity and decision paths. The cardinal signs Capricorn, Cancer and Libra with these degrees are likely to encounter new information and unexpected events related to the houses where critical degrees reside. Pleasant interactions are in the works for a few weeks for Leo and Sagittarius born with planets

at these degrees. Uranus remains in a close square to Pluto in Capricorn along with those strong eclipses which affect world conditions through mid-2016. Recall that this connection is part of a 140-year cycle of Pluto and Uranus that has left many people feeling confused and lacking confidence. Groups and individuals address frustrations over power trips and abuse of authority; more than ever we are asked to prepare for unexpected weather patterns, and be vigilant of the crimes against consumers using Internet and telephone technology that manipulate others' lives. United forces and cooperation help to weather planetary and personal storms. Neptune now retrograde resides in its natural sign Pisces at 8 and 7 degrees, so look at your chart to locate planets or points in Pisces at these degrees. You are experiencing a cycle of release to rid your life of stagnant patterns, especially if Neptune is on your Sun, Ascendant, a house cusp or a planet. While it is retrograde Neptune affects those born February 25-26. Address any insecurities you may be harboring and especially examine the relationship you have with yourself; wide awakenings emerge if you are up to the challenge. Retrograde Pluto moves slowly in Capricorn on the Sun of members of the sign born January 4-5 at 13 degrees of the sign; those with an Ascendant at that point or other key planets feel the vibes. The rest of us should look at any planets or houses where we have 13 degrees of Capricorn, especially Cancer, Aries, and Libra who are undergoing both subtle and intense challenges; or Taurus and Virgo who experience positive vibes from the trine to the Sun or other planets. Watch what happens when you change the tone and quality of communication. Where Pluto makes contact in your chart, it is looking for rebirth in that house. What conditions need your personal attention? Watch the house and make note of what unfolds through fall.

### PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The questions that came in since last month are a mixed bag of topics. Leading the list are those from readers with many questions about the presidential election of 2016 including queries about several contenders triggered by the recent Republican Debate on August 6. My feeling is that many of the hopefuls will be gone before things get serious and I choose not to spend considerable time doing in-depth research on individuals until the field narrows in 2016. To do the job correctly it is necessary to look not only at the candidate's natal chart but also the progressed chart, the solar return and the transits for the year ahead - and then do some comparison to the U.S. chart and to the charts of other candidates. Please understand the brevity of the responses that follow. Of course if an important story breaks I will hop on it for a future issue.

Vice President Joe Biden: I have featured his chart in the past during the 2008 election campaign for one. I do have his time of birth and he is a Scorpio with several placements in the sign, the Ascendant in early Sagittarius the Moon in early Taurus and a number of tie-ins to the U.S. chart. I think the timing if off for a run and see more

about the personal loss of his son, Beau, and the inevitable grieving, and the fact that Saturn in Sagittarius is approaching his Ascendant and sharpens coping skills or increases responsibility in major life areas; and often affects health. Some political types feel he will enter if Scorpio Hillary's popularity wanes due to the e-mail showdown that is looming. She still has the lead among Democrats as I write this section. Readers wanted an additional explanation for the escalating popularity of Gemini Donald Trump: His campaign style is truly attention-getting and many are drawn to him to see what he is going to say. His publicity machine makes sure the press is aware of every move. We are a long way from narrowing down the field; as in previous elections, candidates who have strong aspects in their charts a year prior to the selection process often do not have the staying power to get them to the top in the election year. Like Trump Carly Fiorina, a Virgo born September 6 does not have much experience in politics; ditto Ben Carson, another Virgo born September 18 (an eclipse opposite his Sun in March in his solar house of the public helped bring his star into the limelight). Carly's Moon in harsh aspect to the communicator planet, Mercury can be polarizing to the public and her message has probably been misunderstood by colleagues in different career venues. Voters will have to decide whether they want a President with significant political experience or a less seasoned newcomer to lead the White House in 2017. More than any other election year it is possible to have a strong showing among independent third party candidates vying for the presidency. Stay tuned.

Rachael Ray: Readers continue to comment favorably about coverage of TV chefs so this month I am covering the chart of the immensely popular Rachael Ray, a Virgo born August 25. Rachel has 7 planets in Virgo ranging from 2-28 degrees. This spread shows her to be very focused on perfecting her craft offering dishes that cover all the bases that appeal to people who enjoy food -- sinful, succulent, visually attractive, healthy and crowd-pleasing. She is a double Virgo - Sun and Moon and could possibly be a triple Virgo to include her Ascendant. She examines all facets of cooking and places special emphasis on cooking utensils - no wonder she designed her own line of cookware and has been the successful author of several books and host of a number of Food Network shows as well as her ABC talk show. With Jupiter touching all of her Virgo planets over the next year we'll most likely learn of her plans for expanding the base of her food universe and new products or shows. Rachael has done so much to promote the use of olive oil in Italian and other healthy cuisines that her nickname for it, EVOO, was added to the dictionary a few years back. Mangia!

Frank Gifford, a 12-year veteran of the New York Giants football team and husband of Kathy Lee Gifford was a Leo born August 16 - he and Kathy share the same birthday. He passed away shortly before his 85<sup>th</sup> birthday due to natural causes. According to Kathy he did not like funerals and boxes and anything to do with mourning, so his friends and relatives and members of the Giants and football world came to his home to party in remembrance of his love of life. His Sun in Leo and Mars in Gemini show that he had those great legs that made him a memorable running back and flanker as well as a dynamic sports commentator who used humor and insight to please the viewers.

This month features shared vacation and entertaining dilemmas as well as a query on what to make of a friend's changed behavior. Maybe one or more of these sheds light on your own situation. Enjoy!

O. VACATION BLUES: Two reader couples wrote in about disappointing experiences with their recent shared vacations. While circumstances are a bit different for each I am combining the questions and the respective responses. Couple #1 wrote in saying they have two middle school age children and vacationed at the beach with another couple from their neighborhood two years in a row. The couple also has two children of approximately the same ages and all thought they would save on rental accommodations for two weeks and would be able to participate in similar entertainment and outings. For the second year in a row Couple #1 discovered that the other couple prefers to stay in most nights to play cards, engage in board games and drink and expect the same from their children although they have given their children permission to join Couple #1 at some evening outings. Couple #1 feels this activity is something you can do at home rather than on vacation and also thinks their vacation sharers drink too much. Couple #1 ideally enjoys entertainment venues, swimming, parks, the arcade, walks along the beach, miniature golfing and boat trips that they can share with their children. They don't want to eat out every night but it is vacation and while they will eat breakfast at the rental house and some lunches they want the freedom to enjoy a relaxed schedule and not feel that they have to return at a specific time to help with meal preparation. They have been bored and restless with the others' routine. As they were leaving for home, the other couple wanted to lock in a vacation time for next summer. Couple #1 said they would let them know but have decided not to join them and prefer to take a solo vacation to another location with their children. They have not yet given them their decision and want to know why the two couples approach vacation so differently. The sun signs for Couple #1 are a Leo and Libra while their vacation mates are Taurus and Virgo.

A1. Leo and Libra are two very sociable signs and would thrive on the adventure of breaking routines and seeing what the vacation location has to offer.

Their house mates are both earth signs and while not necessarily true of all earth couples, seem to prefer nesting at home base to taking in the sites and actively participating in recreation. If one or both have a frugal gene they may not want to spend a lot of money on the entertainment and recreational amenities available. Their styles seem to clash and one or both couples would be disappointed after two years of compromise over how to spend the time at the beach. Couple #1 is wise to opt out of a third year. The other couple split the cost of the beach cottage but did not contribute to the food budget nor did they arrive with food, snacks or beverages for themselves or their children and dug right in to the provisions that Couple #2 brought to the cottage. One night toward the end of the vacation their housemates bought a 6-pack of beer, drink mix for the kids and some chips. On nights when they were eating out the second couple only wanted pizza or burgers which they bought for themselves rather than agreeing to a sit-down dinner and returned to the cottage in lieu of taking in the local attractions, going to a movie or participating in any local events. The second couple never offered to reimburse Couple #2 for food nor treat them to a meal. At the end of the vacation the two asked if they could join them again next year but the couple said they were not ready to commit to future plans. Couple #2 wants to know why communications fell apart and whether there was anything in their charts that showed it would be an unsatisfying and costly experience for them. They do not have the birthdays of the other couple.

A2. With the information we have, the answer lies in the chart of the wife in Couple #2 who is a Cancer born July 6 with Libra on the cusp of her 7<sup>th</sup> House and Aries rising on the 1<sup>st</sup> House cusp. Eclipses have been going back and forth on the degree of these two houses. Most particularly when it comes to sharing living quarters, the 7<sup>th</sup> House of partners and roommates describes anything unusual or upsetting in the environment. Additionally Venus in the 4<sup>th</sup> House in Cancer was in harsh aspect to these 14-15 degree eclipses and transiting Pluto in Capricorn and showed that they might have unplanned expenses for luxury items, vacations or entertainment. GENERAL COMMENTS: Whenever you have plans to share an event, vacation or living arrangements with another, be sure you get specific over how costs will be distributed. preferences and some of the likes and dislikes of your roommates to avoid disappointing outcomes. Develop a check list and send it to all parties requesting feedback and concurrence; a week before you get together revisit the list to make you covered all the bases. Then go have fun!
