BIRTHDAY HIGHLIGHTS FOR CAPRICORN

Happy Birthday, Capricorn! Yours is known as the sign of the Goat, the third earth sign, fourth Cardinal sign of the Zodiac and the natural occupant of the 10th House of career, status in life, ambition, authority, father figures, bosses, government, maturity, recognition of achievement and the path to success. Situations occur this year that are right up your alley and you won't have much down time. Expect opportunities for troubleshooting, problem solving, and business changes to be big for you in 2016. Capricorn, your birthday year plays host to your signature planet, Saturn in Sagittarius in your solar 12th House of solitude, regrouping, behind-the-scenes planning, writing, healing, visiting the poor or sick, mystical experiences, secret matters and self-imposed limitations. In this sign and solar house location you won't have high impact unless you have several Sagittarius planets and then it depends on which one of them gets the hard hit. Generally you have to make sure you do not allow negative thoughts to crowd your mind or spend too much time alone. Be sure you don't become a worrywart. Those born December 28-January 7 will make many connections during the year while the planet goes retrograde on March 23 and then returns to direct motion on August 13. You may be involved in less teamwork than normal or have your hands on a project that requires solid concentration and undisturbed space so you can concentrate and whip out a spectacular project or assignment; some will need quiet time to recuperate from illness or accidents; writers regroup and reframe material. If there is just too much

work and too many interruptions, you may be working from home or a remote location. Do your homework well when considering a major change or investment. Jupiter in Virgo occupies your solar 9th House of higher learning, publishing, spirituality, long-distance communication, travel, dealings with those in foreign countries, legal matters, professionals in medicine or law; in-laws, educational opportunities for degree or certification programs or for cross-training in different locations that will benefit your career. All of these areas are open for expansion between the start of your birthday year and September 9 - some of you may already be aware of shifts that are looming. You could have high visibility and receive rewards in the form of promotions, raises, bonuses and new positions. The vote of confidence boosts your spirits and gives you new incentive. On the 9th Jupiter leaves Virgo and heads for Libra and your solar 10th House of career where it stays through the end of your birthday cycle and brings opportunities for success and advancement of your professional goals. Maybe those courses you take are going to pay off or the degree you earn attracts choice employers. Expect life circumstances to change in the fall. Certain Capricorns work on healing fragile family ties or get to know other relatives on deeper levels. Stay optimistic as you work on goals and see them through to completion. Research success models and share them with your work subordinates to inspire confidence in them and foster growth.

Along with activity in your solar 9th and 10th Houses you will also receive a visit from Mars in Scorpio in your solar 11th House from January 4 - March 5 where the planet of passion, energy and innovation stirs up activity with your favorite groups and organizations. You could be spending more time with friends and professional associates. You may be on task to lead an initiative, take on more responsibility, introduce new concepts and goals, to work with humanitarian groups or volunteer for a political or social program. Those two months in Scorpio can be lively and exhausting and set the stage for completion of plans later in the year. Then Mars moves to Sagittarius and your 12th House for a long period of time from March 5 through September 27. In that location you have time to recover from exhaustion but you're a Capricorn so you will probably work beyond capacity to get everything in order for the next phase of your life. Guard your health, avoid exposure to infectious disease; get a dental checkup and a thorough physical if you feel low on energy. No matter how tempting it may be avoid verbal clashes with people who rub you the wrong way. Inspect your new purchases like cars, plumbing, refrigerators and sprinkler systems carefully for leaky components and read up on warranties. Take a nice vacation in a fun, relaxing environment. You often see me state that Pluto just crawls along traveling 3-4 degrees a year - just to make sure you get the message and it sinks in for you. Pluto in Capricorn in your solar 1st House makes a huge statement this year and reveals how you are taking action in your life especially if your birthday is January 5-9. You have had a tremendous amount of tension in your life for several years - as far back as 2008 for some of you. This position makes you intensely focused and helps you pour considerable energy into your hopes, dreams and personal ambition; you earn career recognition now. Early in your birthday year you will make an important life decision and proceed in a new direction. Life lessons are realistic now and if you are up to the test, you win the prize via patience and positive thinking. I'll be surprised if you haven't developed an eagle eye for details by now. Remember that Pluto relates to major changes and resisting its power is futile. Give up what no longer has value. embrace the elements of change and start over to enjoy the banquet waiting for you.

The last two eclipses of 2015 are still playing a leading role in your chart through March 8 and 23 respectively. The September 13th solar eclipse in Virgo in your travel-happy 9th House could mean you book the trip of a lifetime at a location on your dream sheet. You may also find you are heading in a new direction on the work front and take classes or sign up for a degree program in a new field of expertise; others plan for retirement. When you're not on vacation or studying you may find yourself entertaining in-laws and visitors from other countries or longdistance states. The writer in you gains momentum if that is your passion. The final lunar eclipse of 2015 took up residence in Aries in your solar 4th House of home and foundation on September 27. With transiting Uranus in Aries also in this sector the focus is on family matters and sudden developments surrounding them. Possible occurrences include a shakeup of the status quo via moving, illness, sale of your home, residents moving in or out, erratic behavior, arguments, a death or multiple residential decisions. Make necessary changes and attract harmony instead of angst the eclipse is powerful through March 23. The first solar eclipse of 2016 occurs on March 8 in Pisces in your 3rd House of the mind, education, community, communication, media and computer themes, transportation, neighbors, cousins, siblings and events close to home. Pay attention to your intuition and act on hunches while verifying facts with your practical mind. If you have been feeling that contacts are giving you mixed messages or sharing variations of the truth, sort through the confusion and clarify with the right questions. This eclipse stays active through early September. Two weeks later you experience the first lunar eclipse when the full

moon falls in Libra in your solar 10th House of authority lines, career and status in life. Everything to do with stability is a possibility: moves, transfers, employee or company acquisitions, financial analysis, and job partnerships. Certain Capricorns may experience reorganizations that affect operations and the chain of command; others deal with parents or household residents. With Mars in Scorpio here for a long time during 2016 expect differences of opinion in the 11th House of company resources; you could play a role in sorting them out. Mars hangs out here through July and could take a real energetic hit on associations; it may also help you realize ambitions or produce intense levels of conflict in critical areas. With the strong action of the eclipse in Libra, a new boss could fall from esteem in your eyes or you are forced to handle someone else's responsibilities. You could fall in love with a 10th House person. On September 1, 2016 a solar eclipse falls in your solar 9th House in Virgo accelerating your timetable for travel, training and completing contracts. Your social life and personal goals may mesh with career responsibilities. Funding matters become important both on the job and personally while you simultaneously deal with work associates and consult with legal or organizational development experts. Some seek the help of medical professionals. You may also visit relatives at a distance or fund a visit for someone with a cash flow problem. The last Lunar Eclipse of 2016 occurs on September 16 in Virgo's opposite sign, Pisces in your solar 3rd House of the mind and communication. This could be the time to gain insight into relatives or neighbors who are sending puzzling messages. You may also spend time daydreaming or feeling more creative than usual and not wanting so much mental pressure. PLANET ACTIVITY FROM DECEMBER 21-JANUARY 20

Let's take a look at the planetary activity closest to the holiday. Note that Uranus goes direct on Christmas Day at 10:53 PM EST. Uranus most affects Aries born April 4-7 and members of Cancer, Libra and Capricorn born around 16 degrees of their signs. While in this position Uranus makes a strong aspect to Pluto transiting in Capricorn. Those born in the listed signs above may revisit the theme of unfinished business, some of which surfaced as early as 2010 but especially from 2012-15. The energy may come in the form of anger, anxiety, impulsiveness, abrupt movement and

impatience. When in doubt call in a mediator or get help in sorting out feelings. It is no accident that we have seen so much radical behavior on the planet in the form of terrorism, violence and senseless attacks on others. Another two years will go by before we lose this harsh pattern affecting the globe. Also noteworthy is the lunation closest to the start of Capricorn's cycle, the Full Moon in Cancer on Christmas Day, something that has not occurred for 38 years and won't happen again until 2034. Mercury goes retrograde in early Aquarius at 8:06 AM on the 5th of January and slides back into Capricorn on the 9th where it goes direct on January 25. This year the Mercury retrogrades will be in earth signs and four of them will occur since the first one is close to the start of the year. Follow the regular procedures for managing the retrograde cycle for the planet of communication - don't start anything new or sign important documents unless you check the aspects of your chart carefully, especially on either January 5 or 25. Do finish projects you started, clean out your closets, cull through holiday decorations and make a donation to a favorite charity, answer correspondence and make contact with individuals you have not seen or talked to for awhile. Venus ends its time in determined, intimacy-oriented Scorpio and moves into travel loving Sagittarius on the 29th where it resides until the beginning of the Aquarius cycle. While in Scorpio financial discussions may take on an intense note - be sure you don't have them on the holiday itself. The Sagittarius leg of Venus dominates most of the Capricorn cycle and helps you get in touch with playtime, adventure and going outside the box to connect with loved ones. Mars occupies Libra through January 3 and heads to Scorpio through the rest of the cycle and beyond. Mars normally represents impulsiveness; in this case it may also lead to big revelations, true confessions and going over the top to let the cat out of the bag when discretion might be the better option. Certain individuals may experience tremendous relief if the information comes to light through their own actions or scorched if someone beats them to the punch and exposes their truth. Jupiter in Virgo has a huge influence on the recent talks in Paris by nations around the globe to acknowledge the need to reduce and contain climate change. Jupiter is close to the North Node of the Moon and directs our attention to stewardship of the earth's resources which is likely to put environmental issues in the spotlight in the year ahead. When Jupiter is in Virgo health issues dominate the spotlight and lead us to improve health, fitness and nutrition regimens. Jupiter goes retrograde late on January 7 where it remains until May 9. Be prepared to focus on inner awareness, practical decision making and a spot-on evaluation of your life. You will hear much about self-help avenues and triggers that lead to positive behavioral change.

Saturn in Sagittarius most affects Sagittarians born December 31-January 3 this month as well mutable signs Pisces, Gemini and Virgo born around the 10th-13th degree of their signs which adds tension and a sense of urgency to solving pending matters. Saturn favorably affects Aries and Libra born around those degrees. Politics and participants in the upcoming presidential election encounter exposure of faulty claims on the truth-o-meter from candidates eager to win points with voters. Responsibility and coming clean with facts fall under the ongoing Saturn-Neptune square that encourages the shedding of illusions and deceptive news items. On a personal level the message is to sort out the truth and discard perceptions that have no validity. Neptune in Pisces moves slowly in direct motion now affecting those born February 25-28, as well as early water and earth signs located at 7-8 degrees. Clear away seeds of doubt and fear while you embrace change that leads to greater self-confidence. Matters that make the news or affect your life during the next month

could relate to discoveries of toxins in the environment, questionable food quality, breakthroughs in drug treatments, and help for suffering refugees or homeless people. Transiting Pluto in Capricorn occupies the 14th and 15th degrees of the sign during this cycle and most affects Capricorns born January 1-3 and all cardinal signs at 14-15 degrees including where you have your Ascendant. Pluto symbolizes any situations in your life that are out of control or people who demonstrate hostility toward you. Refer to the passages involving Uranus and Pluto in this and earlier newsletters. Do not allow this psychologically damaging behavior to continue if you have been keeping mum about the seriousness of your angst. You can lose years on the quality and length of your life. Understanding Pluto can help you release what you no longer need. Develop clear insight and probe the depths of your inner world. Chiron the Wounded Healer is direct now in Pisces and most affects those born March 6-9 who are working through pain, puzzles and sensitive matters. Search for clarification before taking action. READERS' CORNER

Last month's column had readers asking for more Feng Shui tied to Astrology and said they were fascinated by the shotgun style house purchase. Some wanted to know if the individual bought the house and what they did to correct the energy pattern. No, no purchase was made yet. Others commented on the seesaw pattern in the other reader's chart and want more info on their own patterns. A few identified with the seesaw and described several years of upheavals in their lives. In most cases in this sample cardinal houses were involved - and cardinal signs would write in about their experiences. I appreciate the interest you show in these topics.

In the last few months readers have sent questions on the topic of prosperity, developing a prosperity consciousness and understanding what it takes to feel and be financially sound while achieving life balance. Not surprisingly among them were 3 Capricorn Sun signs who wrote in for advice. This sign is renowned for its focus on career and achievement. The first response provides some insight. The second question comes from a reader who is interested in the type of boundaries I set in answering reader questions in this column. I hope you find some helpful advice.

Prosperity wears many faces. The key is unlocking your potential and understanding the specifications that make you feel wealthy. What you hold in your heart about prosperity determines how successfully you experience it. Your thought patterns lead to either a world of success or a prison of gloom. If you equate prosperity solely with having money, you may not realize that you are your **OWN** money based on your choices and the resulting energy exchange. Each Sun sign embraces prosperity with a unique perspective and desired end result. If things have seemed out of kilter, you may be unaware that you are generating conditions contrary to your hopes and desires. Are you choosing from a menu or taking life as it comes? Perhaps this is your year to make a career change, expand your business, or learn a new skill. You may be contemplating a new car, a trip to an exotic island, or the purchase of your dream house. Maybe you want to improve the quality of your relationships or seek avenues of spiritual growth. Over the years I developed several workshops on this theme that cover all the signs. The material is based on the Prosperity series and some of it appeared in my Llewellyn article, ON THE PATHWAY TO PROSPERITY - A JOURNEY THROUGH THE SIGNS. Here's a takeaway if you are a Capricorn.

Q. Please tell me more about the prosperity attitude of a Capricorn, the good points especially. I want to have more of it. How can I embrace it? I feel I often miss

the mark; others tell me I am stingy with my time and often with my money. I prefer work, especially alone, to teamwork or bonding with others. I was born on December 29.

A. Capricorn, you are known as the Comeback Kid. You are capable of cultivating new habits and internalizing the desired changes. Use the themes that follow as a guide.

<u>Creativity Quotient:</u> Soul survival; inspiring role model in resource regeneration, career recycling, and benefit from recovery; commissioned work in research or writing; furniture restoration; dressmaking; secret surprises; self-healing.

<u>Partnerships and Other Relationships:</u> Appreciation for your ideas and ingenuity; admiration for your attention to details; teamwork that encourages energy exchanges; material stability a must; inner sadness till you find real love; happier later in life.

Attitude: I fell out of the crib and into the job market. I'll get around to letting go...

Rewarding Others For Making you Look Good: Short elegant lunches with a brief thank you speech, eloquent citation, and a big check. (Nothing after hours)

<u>Earning Power:</u> Two incomes - you're a workaholic; outstanding income potential when you make efficient use of time and resources; rewarded for exacting details.

- A. Thank you for your kindness. I enjoy answering your questions. The idea of this column is to show readers how knowledge of astrology and your chart are useful in solving everyday problems. For starters, I avoid answering questions that are too personal or too graphic. They are better suited to one-on-one consultations. Sometimes writers ask anatomical questions or want to talk about poor table manners or hygiene and very specific gross topics connected with them. Another pressing topic is **health** which comes up frequently and must be handled carefully - I am not a doctor and don't diagnose ailments. Despite the fact that I know a lot about a client's health from analyzing his/her chart I do not bring those details into a question in this column. The questions in this column are not suited to issues that would involve a great deal of time to analyze. Sometimes a reader asks for what amounts to a consultation rather than a question by requesting a life update such as where they are headed, the next steps, insight into relationships, or the problems at the workplace. I will often ask them to break down the guery so I can answer something specific for them but more often they do not get back to me. Others want a full comparison of two parties - the reader and their romantic interest - not the right venue for this very complicated task. I also feel it is inappropriate to respond when specific personal questions that sound like prying come in about celebrities, sports figures, and politicians. Often these are baiting questions and I scrub them from a direct response. If the names are in the news I might feature the parties in the People, Places and Topics in the News section supplying limited details. Another scenario, which happens rarely, occurs when certain readers use an anonymous e-mail address to send me personal criticism. Their temporary e-mail address disappears immediately. A recent example came from someone wanting to know how I could consider myself spiritual since I eat meat and develop recipes that include it. Finally, I occasionally get mail from someone wanting information about an individual they know is a client of mine - usually a relative, close friend or significant other. You can be sure those details are not going to be disclosed in this column. Keep on writing, Readers; queries welcome.
