Eclipses last from 6 months to a year while their influence plays out. I am covering the last two eclipses of 2016 in this section since they occurred this month and will influence your chart through February 2017 and beyond. Sometimes you get a feel for what eclipses can do in your chart weeks before they take place. On September 1 a solar eclipse occurred in Virgo in your 12th House of the unconscious, hidden matters, behind-the-scenes activity, regeneration, mystical matters, psychic phenomena, charity, visiting the sick, widows, orphans, or secret enemies. When this eclipse landed it promised the discovery of new or unknown information that is coming to light. The disclosures may involve a few or many parties; some info revolves around people who are ill or in hospitals or places of confinement. It also helps you go within and meditate or seek personal space. For certain Libras you could be tempted to leave your home or have an affair if other factors are present in your chart. You could also spend time working on goals and your future. Many Libras get in touch with the gift for intuiting the truth. It influences your chart strongly through February 26 and through August 2017. Last week's September 16 eclipse was a lunar eclipse in Pisces and occurred in your solar 6th House of work and personal environments, health, pets, co-workers, business or home organization, mental health, fitness and food. This eclipse showcases major work environment activity occurring since March and sheds light on the distribution of tasks. If you are in supervisory position, you may be counseling staff, scheduling training or evaluating efficiency. Colleagues may be major internal clients needing guidance. Neptune is also present so you may have to cull out behavior or poor working habits that are slowing productivity. For those not employed this eclipse points to getting a clean bill of health and changing habits via exercise and nutrition. Some will buy a pet for companionship. The first solar eclipse of 2017 occurs in Pisces on February 26 in

your solar 6th House of health, daily environment and routines, pets, co-workers, mental outlook, and sense of organization. This eclipse may influence your personal energy patterns and points to a good time to have a checkup. The eclipse aids in goal achievement and encourages consistency rather than daydreaming; journal for success and internalize affirmations. Enjoy this new beginning and direct your efforts to a meaningful change - career, job, retirement, studies, a different employer, the healing or metaphysical arts, or a nutrition plan that gives you vital energy. If you are born on or around October 3-5 the influence is very strong so, get ready to act. The first lunar eclipse of 2017 occurs on February 10 in Leo in your solar 11th House so you get a chance to work on your affiliation with associations, groups, organizations, friendships and your personal goals. Those of you born October 14-16 experience a very significant year in terms of leadership opportunities, personal enjoyment, relationships with others, major lifestyle changes, travel, and commitment to emerging initiatives. The last solar eclipse of 2016 occurs in Leo on August 21 and is visible in north America. SEPTEMBER 22-OCTOBER 22 PLANETS

This cycle highlights Mercury going direct in Virgo early on the 22nd and giving you the signal to take action on important decisions you have put on hold since August 30th. From the mail I received I learned that several of you had Mercury delays and mix-ups with insurance matters, medical procedures, vehicles on the fritz, missed phone calls, misplaced keys, and weather delays. Hopefully you are back on track and ready to sign agreements. Watch for fallout from the September eclipses if you have planets at Virgo 9° or Pisces at 24°. Some receive happy surprises or the goahead to resume cherished plans. Mars in Sagittarius livens up the charts of fire signs Aries, Leo and Sagittarius and lends passion to pursuits. It's a great time for inspiration and brainstorming. Jupiter moved to Libra on the 9th and affects early degrees of the sign mostly for those born September 22-30. Get your goals on the table and look for sales for items you are ready to buy. Venus is about to move rapidly through Scorpio from September 24th through October 18th so don't be surprised if passion for people, places and events is in the air. Plan wisely for fall getaways. Saturn is in Sagittarius where is remains until December 2017 and most affects individuals born December 2-6; Aries born March 30 - April 3 and Leos born August 2-6 also get a positive boost in direction while those born February 29 - March 4 and September 2-6 feel a need to scrutinize proposals, manage added responsibility and take good care of your health; energy patterns fluctuate. As we begin this Sun in Libra report Chiron is retrograde in Pisces all through the end of the cycle and most affects individuals born March 10-12 who experience powerful deep level mental and physical healing as they let go of fear and embrace courage. Address what holds you back, to free up energy and enjoy life. Go ahead and sigh in relief. Uranus is retrograde in Aries and visits the Sun of those born April 10-12. Everyone, especially the cardinal signs should check your chart for planets in aspect to 22-23 degrees of Aries for areas of vulnerability. During this cycle Uranus opposes the Sun and creates challenges with Pluto in Capricorn. You'll feel the shakeup deeply in whatever houses the aspect appears yet it will serve as a wakeup call to correct what is out of balance in your life. PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

Readers have sent in a mixed bag of questions regarding celebrities like Ryan Lochte, Dancing with The Stars contestants (coverage next month although watch Laurie Hernandez, James Hinchcliffe, Kenny "Baby Face" Edmonds, Terra Jole, Jana Kramer and Marilu Henner), America's Got Talent winners, the possibility of a war on U.S. soil (upcoming eclipses could be a factor in the year ahead), and political outcomes. Here is this month's sampler.

Ryan Lochte: The Olympic medalist created global flak when he concocted a story about being robbed at gunpoint in Rio during the Olympics. Ryan is a Leo born on August 3 in Rochester, NY, with several Leo placements and his Leo Sun in direct square to natal Uranus, often the signature of conflict with authority figures when triggered by transiting planets. Saturn hit his natal Uranus during the games and the incident cost him his good name and several lucrative endorsements. Shortly after the Olympics, Dancing with the Stars announced he would be competing on Season 23. The very first week protesters disrupted his performance on the dancefloor further igniting the Uranian chaos that is present. Hopefully, he can channel the spontaneity of the planet into creating memorable dances with his partner Cheryl Burke.

Political Picture: We're coming down the stretch; it's time to hold the debates and see what plans for the nation are in the cards for the presidential winner. Readers asked about Kellyanne Conway's birthdate. She is born January 20 on the Capricorn/Aquarius cusp in Hammonton, NJ (time unknown) and joined the Trump campaign last month. Her chart is popping with Virgo/Pisces eclipse energy and she is in it to shake up the status quo. Still another birth time emerged for Hillary as astrologers compete to figure out the outcome of the race based on new information. Stay tuned.

America's Got Talent (AGT): This show continues to be highly successful having just completed Season 11 with some of the most talented performers ever featured in a single season. Judges: Simon Cowell, a Libra born October 7; Heidi Klum, is a double Gemini born June 1; Mel B is another Gemini born May 29; Comedian Howie Mandel is a Sagittarius born November 29; Host Nick Cannon is a Libra born October 8. No doubt all of the top 10 performers will achieve fame in future months.

READERS' CORNER

Several readers responded to last month's "Corner" in response to the information on timing a move and real estate and asked for more. Several readers sympathized with the man whose fiancée did not want to invite her mother's significant other to their upcoming wedding and said he should wake up to his partner's selfishness before the wedding. This month I received several questions regarding world conditions and people in the news as well as an inquiry about an article I wrote about "9/11."

Q. A colleague of mine told me that you wrote a 9/11/01 article for Llewellyn some years ago. I would like to know how that came about and how I can get a copy of it. It is a topic dear to my heart especially since the terrorism in the world is escalating. Thank you.

A. The day is forever etched in my mind as well. Thank you for writing. The article you cite was called "Astrology Looks at a Changing World" and appeared in the 2003 Llewellyn Moon Sign Book. I suggest you contact Llewellyn to purchase this book as they usually have previous issues in their inventory. The article is way too long to fit in this space so I will provide you with some of the details. I was actually scheduled to write a different article for the 2003 Moon Sign edition but when I returned from being stranded on 9/11 and discussed what happened with my editor she asked me to write an article about the event instead. I'm honored I could do it.

On September 11, 2001 I was living in northern Virginia about 10 miles from Dulles Airport. On that beautiful perfect Tuesday morning I was headed to the airport to board a plane for Denver where I would then make a connection to Las Vegas to meet my sister, Amy for a 3-day reunion. Everything was working smoothly at the airport, in fact my United flight took off early, something that rarely happens. But how was I to know that the World Trade Center had been struck moments before and I would not know the details for several hours as my plane, along with all the others stranded on flight paths, would be ordered grounded and sent to airports with available landing options. Eventually my plane landed in Indianapolis after circling the airport for more than an hour and I was not able to get home for days because Dulles airport was one of the last airports to reopen after the tragedy (I and a fellow passenger eventually drove home once rental cars became available because our flights were canceled every day while we passed the time in an airport hotel).

Background: In the summer of 2001 I began to see an Arab man in my meditation routine. I knew this figure was a clue to something that would affect my life, but as I usually do, I just wait for events to unfold knowing the pieces will fit

together. The Monday before the terrorist hijackings (September 10), a client phoned to ask me whether she ought to drive her own car to New York City that weekend or book a rental. She was concerned about whether her 10-year-old vehicle could withstand the trip since her passengers included her daughter and grandchildren. After consulting the ephemeris and her natal chart transits, I told her I didn't feel there was anything wrong with her car but advised her to have it serviced anyway. I told her I did see another type of problem involving mass transportation in New York City and that it would somehow influence her trip. Too close for comfort? Read on. My client, the owner of an insurance agency (Eighth House of Death and Estate Matters), also knew that I was flying out of town the very next day via Dulles Airport and wanted to catch me before I left. Later on we would have some very interesting chats. Another client of mine in Colorado related that I told him shortly after George W. Bush emerged as the President that our country could go to war the latter half of the year. You can be sure he contacted me in September after the attacks on our Nation.

My theory is that several planets had a hand in the unfolding horror, but I was particularly drawn to the behavior of transiting Neptune right before the attack at the time of the September 2nd full Moon in Pisces. I also looked at transiting Mercury and the degree caught my eye because it was in an esoteric degree that gives me the chills anyway. It translates to "the dawn of a new day reveals everything changed" according to Dane Rudhyar, a renowned humanistic astrologer. Whenever this degree appears in the charts of my clients by progression or transit, some aspect of that client's life undergoes a drastic change. Very few individuals in the astrological community actually narrowed down the attacks by Osama Bin Laden's handpicked crew to that infamous day, but many saw the astrological conditions unfolding. I salute those who linked this fateful day to a disaster similar to Pearl Harbor. I was not one who knew the actual day or the horrific extent of events that would occur. My astrology-based suspicions, aided by my gift of intuition, were that our powerful country would emerge on the world stage under very unusual circumstances with Saturn and Pluto opposing each other in the US chart's 1st and 7th Houses (I use the Gemini rising chart for July 4, 1776). I also felt the Cancer-Capricorn eclipses in our 2nd and 8th money houses would influence new spending bills, our country's debt load, the stock market, and redefine the options for employment in government and the Nation as a whole. I doubt that much could have been done to prevent the attacks even though many of us were studying the astrological aspects. All the systems of detection and internal watchdog agencies seemed to fail in the art of surveillance and suppression of dissidents. Intelligence forces missed out on coordinating critical information and connecting the puzzle pieces. Perhaps world history needed to be written so that people on the planet could rediscover their purpose, evaluate complacency, and find new resources for healing.
