PLANETS in ACTION OCTOBER 22 through NOVEMBER 21

Uranus, Neptune and Chiron are retrograde now. Readers are scratching their heads this week telling me how erratic the energy has felt. The feeling is

compliments of the Full Moon in Aries on the 16th, a/k/a, the Hunter Moon and the first of three super moons that occur through the end of this year. it also serves as a power broker and there is a lot of competition playing out in the Universe. **Jupiter in Libra** most affects those born October 1-8 with the conjunction on their suns; these individuals have decisions to make regarding growth opportunities, purchases, investments and personal gain. Be fair with others and honor commitments. Globally leadership that takes a teamwork approach meets with success and business ventures get a boost. **Saturn is direct in Sagittarius during this cycle traveling over 13-16 degrees of the sign and most affecting those born December 4-9. With a beneficial boost from transiting Jupiter in Libra your business and purchase plans have a high success rate ratio.** This transit also helps Aries and Leos born with planets at 13-16 degrees of their signs; those born with these degrees in Gemini, Virgo and Pisces may experience challenges or wide awakenings. Get rid of faulty assumptions and review plans to put your wish list in motion. **Uranus in Aries** is retrograde traveling over the 21st degree of the sign and **most affecting Aries born April 9-11**. PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS:

In this section the dominant questions revolve around the election and the last debate in Las Vegas between the candidates running for president. Mars on Pluto added to the edginess and feeling of war or anger on the 19th and affected the charts of the candidates for President, especially Donald Trump whose Sun in Gemini is conjunct natal Uranus (shooting from the hip; making statements for shock value and having a shallow grasp of facts) and the Moon's North Node. So many lunar aspects occurred it felt like a Full Moon. The Moon was in Gemini on the 19th often related to double talk, deliberate misunderstanding - maybe stretching the truth or denying earlier revelations, repeating false gossip and tricking with numbers. The Moon was in hard aspect to transiting Saturn in Sagittarius and Uranus in Aries was hitting Trump's natal Saturn and Venus in Cancer in his 11th House of organizations, indicating that treatment of women and domestic policy was going to be a factor in the debate dialog as well as denial of accusations and information captured on tape. The September 16th lunar eclipse in his 8th House of sex, intimacy and power also brought out the complaints from women. Note that this house represents the GOP in his chart and the Party's disenchantment with his demeanor has been high. If you watched the debate you know that Hillary Clinton took heat on health care, the 2nd Amendment, WikiLeaks, Putin/Russian intervention in the US election outcome, immigration policy, abortion, Supreme Court nominations and toward the end of the debate, "The Donald" called her a nasty woman. Uranus in Gemini in Hillary's chart was blasted full on in the entire 90 minutes; yet she seemed the most prepared and as I write this on October 20th, the poll numbers reflect more favorably for her. Among his most shocking statements delivered at the end of the debate was Trump's declaration that he would consider the election rigged if he is not satisfied with the outcome of the election; is not going to agree to support the winner unless it is he; and is keeping his ultimate strategy to himself. Pundits talked all night and into the day about the debate, declaring Hillary the winner and stating that Donald fell apart after a strong first half hour. Shortly after Trump left and arrived at his hotel (constructed with Chinese steel), he tweeted that he won the debate.

On October 20, WikiLeaks announced that it hacked President Obama's private e-mails years ago and released his address, even letting the public know how to read those e-mails. On the evening of the 20th both candidates attended the annual Al Smith Dinner, a major fundraising event for Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese in NYC. Trump and Clinton were featured speakers (by running for president) in a format where the speakers use self-deprecating humor to exaggerate their shortcomings and entertain the attendees. Trump went first, started off well enough with corny jokes and then went into full campaign mode attack launching uncomfortable zingers aimed largely at Hillary and members of the media who were in the audience. The elite crowd grew increasingly uncomfortable and booed him - an unprecedented occurrence at these dinners. Then he took his seat next to Cardinal Dolan who sat between the two

candidates. For full details read the newspaper headlines and follow the stories on-line. After this week's events, especially Trump's refusal to accept the outcome of the election, the anguished Republican Party is scrambling to protect their seats and preserve congressional majorities. What a world! Don't forget to vote! Next month we'll discuss the outcome. Check past newsletters for candidate chart analysis.

Ms. Pascale got her start as a baker at the famous Selfridge's in London for those of you familiar with the PBS program, Mr. Selfridge, and later opened her own bakery in Covent Garden, Ella's Bakehouse, named after her daughter. Her solar chart shows spontaneous insight into baking creations, making them a thing of beauty with her Pallas, Venus and Uranus conjunction in artistic Libra; yet 5 planets/asteroids in Scorpio show that she does not waver in expecting perfection in texture and form in her own work or from contestants she judges. An abundance of water planets show that she deeply feels the inspiration coming through while her Vesta/Saturn conjunction in Gemini indicate creative hands, a critical eye and excellent communication skills. READERS CORNER

I received more mail than usual this month with many questions about my 9/11/01 experience that I recounted in the Libra 2016 newsletter and am replying so that everyone has the desired information they seek. I have listed a few questions below and addressed as many as possible in the answer block. I have more material than I can cover here and will provide additional details in future newsletters. Thank you for your interest.

Q. Would you please share more about your feelings leading up to the 9/11 tragedy? Can you include information about your classes and findings in the year prior to 9/11? What planets were involved on 9/11? With so many people dying at one time, does this show up in their charts? What was going on in the plane you boarded after it started to head to another airport? The highlighted questions are the ones I am covering in this newsletter.

A. During the nine months preceding the hijackings, I made several references to national safety, terrorist threats including high-jacked planes, biological warfare,

the President's chart (George W. Bush), and the US chart being the high focus of attention by enemies. In a workshop the Sunday before Election Day 2000, I related that election night would be a fiasco due to the planetary lineup that included Mercury going from retrograde to stationary direct while polls were closing (mix-ups in communication), the Moon going void of course in Neptune-ruled Pisces (chaos and confusion), and Mars opposing the Moon in early Libra (public disagreements over results). I indicated we would go to bed without knowing the outcome. I also used to conduct an annual seminar each December and outline the global and individual trends for the year ahead. The agenda included topics of interest such as world themes, finances, politics, entertainment figures, and the outlook for each Sun sign. I track eclipse patterns by solar houses so that clients have a clue about which department of life will be most affected by eclipse activity in the year ahead. That is my strongest contribution to what others call predictive astrology. I like to say it is the astrology of choice because I believe the chart is a guide and you have options for facilitating the outcomes.

In December of 2000 the date of my annual looking ahead workshop fell before the recount results of the 2000 election were known. Rather than turn the event into a political fiasco if I tipped my hand (strong Republicans and Democrats were present including future political appointees), I chose to cover the chart of Vice-President-To-Be Dick Cheney in the political segment. Only the astrologically astute caught on to my hint. My advice to attendees was to keep this man's chart handy because we would be learning a lot about how he does business and his health in the months ahead. I also asked the group to pray for the incoming President and indicated the winner would be the loser as critical events would claim his attention day and night shortly after the eclipses in the summer of 2001. How true it all came to be. I told a client shortly after George W. Bush emerged as the President that our country could go to war the latter half of the year. You can be sure he contacted me in September after the attacks on our Nation. Several similar revelations occurred during monthly workshops that further pointed to the role of Congress and the intensity in the astrology charts of the Cancer President, the Aries Sun sign Secretary of State Colin Powell, National Security Advisor Condoleezza Rice with her cadre of Scorpio planets receiving harsh aspects from the transits of Uranus and Neptune, and Defense Secretary Donald Rumsfeld, another Cancer with critical ties to the US chart.

In 2001 all my travel prior to September 11 had involved business trips. I had little free time on my calendar and was ready for a short getaway to recharge my batteries. (Capricorn rising with Saturn and Mercury in the Sixth House tends to be a workaholic.) When my Florida-based Pisces sister suggested in late August that we meet in Las Vegas for a three-day reunion (she already planned to be there with a friend), I booked a flight that would take me first to Denver where I would make a connection to Las Vegas. Travel aspects were good for me - transiting Jupiter (long distance travel) in Cancer was conjunct my Sun - yet something did not feel right to me as departure time approached.

The Sunday before our trip I wrapped up after a seminar and phoned my younger son in San Francisco (the destination city of United Flight 93 which crashed into the Somerset County, PA area) to give him my flight information. I told him that I am usually very upbeat and excited when I am traveling and was looking forward to seeing my sister, but something seemed very different about this trip. I thought perhaps it

was because I had never been to Las Vegas and had little interest in gambling. I mentioned I had scheduled a side trip to tour Hoover Dam to get away from the smoke (Neptune) in the casinos. With his gregarious Aquarian personality, he assured me that I would have a good time and encouraged me to enjoy the reunion. Late the next evening while I was packing (hours after the New York City-bound client I mentioned in last month's newsletter had phoned), my oldest son (Libra) called and asked me to phone him when I landed in Denver on the morning of the 11th. I told him I needed to catch a connecting flight that didn't have much wiggle room for being late, but he insisted that I call from my cell phone and then went on to request that I phone him immediately when I landed on the ground in Las Vegas. I knew he was picking up on something (he has the Moon in Taurus intuitively placed in the 9th house and has psychic Neptune sextile Pluto and the Ascendant in the 3rd house), especially since he had never made such a request before this time. He also has strong ties to the World Trade Center since it was the national headquarters of his former employer, a well-known investment firm and he had just been to the Center for a week of management training. Ironically, I have a third child, a daughter who lived at the time in Los Angeles, the intended arrival city of three of the four high-jacked planes. Can you imagine what my family was going through while I was in the air oblivious to the violence taking place in eastern sky space?
