### PLANETS' POSITIONS FROM NOVEMBER 21-DECEMBER 21

The 2016 Presidential Election: Astrologers and pollsters around the globe are beating themselves up for missing one of the most dramatic political upsets in American history. Upwards of 90 percent named Hillary Clinton as the winner instead of Donald Trump. In the past week, I have received abundant communication from individuals, many of them astrologers, asking how we missed it? You did not miss the outcome: both were correct -- Hillary won the popular vote by over 2.5 million votes. In the Inauguration Day chart for 2017 which tells a lot about the winner, the Moon in Scorpio, representing the people was on several of Hillary's natal planets and favored her chart. Unless you progressed the President Elect's chart for election day, you would have missed a major life progression occurring when his Sun in Gemini advanced to his late Leo Ascendant conjunct Mars in Leo, his rising planet. The Sun does not advance to every person's Ascendant and when it does it is a one in a lifetime occurrence that about 12 percent of the population experiences. Trump's Sun connects to the U.S. Mars showing that he has strong affinity for the military and Mars (war, conflict, passion) may play a big role in his presidency as we examine his planets in the months ahead. Although most astrologers discounted a 5<sup>th</sup> eclipse this year on August 18 in late Aquarius and did not include it, I believe it did play a role in boosting visibility in Trump's chart in the opposition position to his Ascendant/Mars conjunction. And later this year on August 21, his chart will experience a direct

eclipse on those degrees. As for the pollsters and pundits, they were wrong and completely misread the public feedback. Shockingly nearly 46 percent of eligible voters did not cast a vote, and in certain states, more than 100,000 ballots did not select either candidate voting down-ticket only. And right in sync with Mercury turning retrograde, The Electoral College meets on December 19 to cast their ballots.

Demaris Phillips is a Kentucky-born American chef: This talented winner of the 9<sup>th</sup> season of Food Network Star, launched her acclaimed show, "Southern At Heart" on the Food Network. Not surprising, her specialty is southern cuisine and she serves up tasty comfort food, emphasizing the caring relationship between food and love. Demaris is a double Sagittarius born December 8 with several planets in mutable signs indicating that she has favorite recipes yet is not afraid to improvise and probably has more than one version of each favorite. #### READER'S CORNER

Newsletter readers continue to ask for details about my 9/11 experience saying how much they are enjoying the material. Here is Part 3 of my story of this unprecedented journey that addresses the atmosphere on the plane. I'm still working on the questions you sent that appeared in the Libra newsletter and will include Part 4 in Capricorn's newsletter.

September 11, 2001 proved to be a glorious late summer morning in northern Virginia as I headed to Dulles Airport. The sky was blue and cloudless with no hint of approaching autumn. As far as I could see third house activity hummed along without interference. School buses made the rounds picking up children on street corners. I commented to the taxi driver on the unusually light volume of rush-hour traffic (Mercury on its best behavior) and the few passengers who lined up at curbside check-in. I arrived at the airport ninety minutes before departure on my United Airlines flight scheduled to take off at 9:05 AM for Denver. Security was a breeze. Once I reached the gate, boarding began on time, in fact everything seemed too easy - must have been that boost from transiting Jupiter or the Moon on my natal Mercury. Ten minutes before departure the Captain announced that twenty more passengers would board the half-full cabin and he wanted them seated quickly so the plane could take off. Boarding took all of five minutes and the plane started moving away from the gate at 9:00 AM. My mind was whirling and my self-talk marveled that for the first time in three years I was on a United Airlines flight that was leaving on time.

I sat in an aisle seat noting another woman about my age occupied the window seat. We made brief small talk and settled into the reading material we chose for the flight. Before this day would end, we would become instant friends and I would discover that she was born not far from New Baltimore, Pennsylvania (see Scorpio newsletter for references). Coincidence? I don't think so. A little more than half an hour later the captain signaled the flight attendants to begin serving breakfast. They

no sooner served a few passengers in first class, then the captain asked them and everyone else to take their seats. He said the following: "The good news is that you are safe; the bad news is that you are not going to Denver. This flight is heading for Pittsburgh. We have been asked to abort this flight due to a National emergency. Keep your seatbelts fastened and do not use your cell phones or the in-flight telephones." Passengers received no other information from airline personnel about the nature of the emergency for the duration of the very long flight.

A hush came over the already quiet cabin; then people began talking to one another wondering what had happened. A surreal quality hung in the air. I knew it was bad, very bad, yet I felt physically safe. What I am about to tell you is forever etched in my heart. In hindsight, I feel that retrograde Neptune (chaos, confusion, mixed signals) and the void of course Moon leaving transportation-related Gemini were two of the major players in what unfolded during this flight. When my seatmate asked me what I thought had happened, I told her the Captain's message suggested either our country had gone to war, someone had been assassinated, or a plane had been taken hostage. I knew in my sinking heart of hearts that I was right and all of it proved to be true in the end. Soon the Captain signaled the flight attendants to serve breakfast but within a few minutes he told them to take their seats again as we were going to prepare for our landing in Pittsburgh (mixed signals from Mercury and Neptune). Once again he came on the system and told us we were **not** going to land in Pittsburgh because "there were too many planes" and we would head for Indianapolis, Indiana instead. (Although we did not know it at the time, the last of the downed planes had crashed southwest of Pittsburgh Airport in New Baltimore/Shanksville and we would have been unable to pass by that airspace due to the endangered conditions.) As we headed for our target destination, the Captain once again gave the go-ahead for breakfast and just as quickly canceled the possibility of a mid-air feast for the grumbling stomachs of the passengers on our Midwest-bound flight. The tension grew with the uncertainty of information. Even when we received direction to prepare for our landing in Indianapolis, the plane kept circling the airport because no landing strip was open. With air traffic halted nationwide availability was restricted. Then we landed and parked on a remote strip, our interim refuge from the airspace chaos, idling for a few hours awaiting further instructions.

Once on the ground, the captain gave us permission to use the phones and lavatories and everyone jumped up and grabbed their cell phones. He told us we would have to wait for clearance to a gate and because so many planes had landed in this modest-sized airport, the wait time would be considerable. Every plane would be searched and inspected and no baggage would be released. Once again he gave permission to serve the now over-nuked breakfast and we got another taste of the waiting blues. While some of the famished travelers munched on shriveled bagels, several passengers called the rental car agencies at the airport looking for vehicles to get far away from their unplanned stop. Since at least forty other unscheduled planes landed in Indianapolis cars were in short supply. Rumors were flying that airports were targets of mad bombers. Although cell phones appeared in just about every hand, few passengers could get through to anyone on the East Coast because the airwaves were jammed. Bits and pieces of the horror began trickling in to passengers. Hijackings! Bombings! Hostages! The World Trade Center! The Pentagon! Somerset County! Passengers could not put these horrific pictures together. Travelers attempted to call colleagues but no one was answering phones. Washington, DC, government employees

had been evacuated. Reports came in of massive traffic jams and collapsing buildings. What type of monster did we have on our hands?

I had 65 names programmed into my cell phone and I was unable to get through to anyone on either the East or West Coast. My index finger was on automatic pilot hitting the redial button hundreds of times. At last I got through to my San Francisco son's voice mail and left an emotional message requesting him to let everyone know I was safe. I'm sure I didn't sound convincing yet I knew I was physically stable. I found myself getting all too big a picture of the tragedy. My seatmate turned to me for reassurance that we were going to be OK and that I would stay with her. I eked out words of comfort and agreed to stay close. We chatted, exchanged critical information just in case, and kept phoning our loved ones. I knew from all my work in self-help psychology that we were in shock. A stream of information came in and I told her I was afraid of contamination from the debris and Anthrax! Yes, Anthrax! Now where did that come from? Neptune or Pluto? We did not hear that term for a few weeks after the crashes, yet I said it! Right now, I just wanted to be home in familiar surroundings and to hear a cherished voice.
