You are under the influence of the first lunar eclipse of 2017 which took place on February 10 in Leo at 22° & 28' in your solar 5th house of fun, games, dating and social life; risk-taking, sports and recreation. What will it be for you - the strongest part of this eclipse lasts until August 21. The first solar eclipse of 2017 occurred 2 weeks later on February 26 in Pisces at 8 degrees 12 minutes in your solar 12th House of the psychic mind, self-discovery, inner healing, secrets and planning behind the scenes, work with charities and meditation. This one lasts through August. PLANETS IN ARIES' TIME from March 20-April 19

We usher in spring on March 20th at 6:29 A.M. when the Sun moves to Aries and the momentum of the February 10 And February 26 eclipses continue to make an impact on many lives. As we leave March both Venus and Jupiter are retrograde soon to be joined by Saturn on April 6 EDT and Mercury on April 9 EDT. Pluto joins the retrograde gang on the 20th just as the Taurus cycle begins and we'll cover the planet in the next newsletter. These retrograde periods represent reflective times to look over plans, understand more about your needs, decide how to solve problems and reconsider priorities. It is time to build on rather than initiate new plans. Mercury retrograde phases this year spend most of the time in fire signs even though other signs overlap. Mercury goes retrograde in Taurus on April 9 and resumes direct motion the

afternoon of May 3 in early Aries where it stays through May 15. You can make the best progress by cleaning out closets, filing piles of material that are accumulating, shredding unnecessary documents, phoning a friend, and biding your time as appointments are rescheduled, canceled or just plain forgotten. Venus went retrograde in Aries on March 4 and is going direct in Pisces on April 15 zipping through late degrees of the sign before retracing its full journey through Aries. Those of you who had the romantic planets working for you are seeing progress in relationships or are in the beginning stages of a new one. Until Venus goes direct watch investments and don't bet the rent that everything you anticipate in close relationships is on solid ground. The 15th is not a good day for your love life or making cherished decisions. Mars spends the next month in Taurus making deliberate attempts to amplify security in finances, business, and personal partnerships. Solutions are likely to be reversed or tweaked later. Take your time. Jupiter is retrograde in Libra and most affects Libras born October 14-9 in that order until the Taurus cycle begins. Jupiter opposes Uranus in Libra now creating unpredictable situations in love and finances, some of it caused by decisions and misinformation in personal, government and legal arenas. When Saturn turns retrograde in Sagittarius on April 6th it will spend 4 months in this stationary motion which ends on August 25. You have reason to reconsider important issues and lifechanging decisions that involve family, health, real estate ventures, your career, life status and health. The news about health care, retirement benefits, pensions, social security and debt resolutions is inconsistent at best sending mixed signals to the Fed that are not sure raising the interest rates is the best move but will do it anyway. Uranus in Aries is currently making a nice transit to Saturn in fire sign Sagittarius and will benefit those with fire and air planets. While the unpredictable occurs in several ways with Uranus creating havoc, Saturn will be there to point out beneficial rules and regulations in response to public outcry to leaders that are unable to solve matters that require long-term solutions. Expect to hear about several Ad Hoc committees, meetings or boards as well as the Congress convening to focus on strategy. Expect reversals and flip-flopping and raised eyebrows in allied countries. Uranus blazes trails in fiery Aries especially for Aries born April 12-19 and for fire signs Leo and Sagittarius born with the Sun at 23-24 degrees of their signs or planets at 23-24 degrees of fire signs. Aries may experience the most action or disruptions in their lives during this cycle. Neptune in Pisces most affects those born March 1-4 during this time while it makes harmonious connections to Venus in Pisces for most of April and to Pluto in Capricorn. This cycle favors romantic chemistry, solving pending problems and researching facts or medical information. Those most impacted by this cycle have planets at 11-13 degrees of Pisces, Cancer and Scorpio, Wherever transiting Neptune appears in your chart, the house calls attention to areas of confusion, spiritual insight, psychic impressions and matters involving liquids either the drinkable type or those that cause problems via leaks or toxins. Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn feel the impact on planets around 19 degrees of their signs. Those born January 8-11 experience the shift on their suns. Release those damaging and toxic thoughts, focus on health issues that need attention; therapy is good for the soul. Individuals born March 14-17 have Chiron in Pisces on their suns. The February 10 eclipse activated Uranus in his solar 5th House of enterprise, entertainment and risk-taking. No doubt he will get a big boost in the limelight and draw new fans to his circle.

Cat Cora is an Aries born on April 3 in Jackson, MS. This Iron Chef and master of Mediterranean (Greek), Southern, and Fusion cuisine turns 50 this year. She is a graduate of the University of Southern Mississippi and Culinary Institute of America who opened restaurants in the US - San Francisco and Orlando; and in Singapore. Cat has appeared on numerous Food Network shows including Iron Chef America, Kitchen Accomplished, Food Fighters, The Best Thing I ever ate and numerous appearances as a judge on Master Chef, Guy's Grocery Games and Cutthroat Kitchen. Maybe you caught her latest show, My Kitchen Rules on FX this winter which she co-hosts with Curtis Stone. The competition features celebrity couples who use their culinary skills to win the best preparation, presentation and delivery of complete meals that are hosted in a participating couple's home each week. The current round of eclipses in Leo/Aquarius are affecting her 5th House of romance and 11th of friendships and groups adding new people and plans to her life, possibly more restaurants and additional food-related shows. Jupiter traveling through her solar 7th house of partners expands her options and may present new opportunities in other countries.

READERS CORNER

Fans of Readers Corner wrote mostly about relationships over the past month wanting to know more about compatibility. Perhaps you will relate to one or more of these questons.

- Q. I am an Aries born April 5 and my spouse is a Leo born August 7. What can you tell me about our compatibility and the success of the relationship? We have been together 16 years. What works and what does not in your opinion?
- Thank you for writing. You and your spouse share the harmonious connection of having the Sun trine Sun, one of 7 marriage models based on major aspects that astrologers examine for compatibility. Here the Suns are approximately 120 degrees apart. While harmonious Sun Signs do not guarantee a long or happy marriage, neither do stressful aspects like the square, opposition or quincunx rule out a successful marriage. The ideal scenario is for you to have your charts compared for full analysis. Very few couples use only the Sun Sign to determine compatibility and attraction. I'll cover your Sun-Sign relationship here. Using solar houses, you would have the Sun in the 1st House and your husband's Sun in the 5th House of romance (Leo rules the house) and if his Sun were in the 1st House, the chart would show a fire sign on the cusp of his solar 5th House indicating an attraction for either a Sagittarius or an Aries. Each of you has similar approaches to life, common goals and interests. The sameness can be both positive and passive in that too much similar thinking can be boring and leads to the need for seeking outside interests, not necessarily in the form of other partners although that sometimes occurs. Maybe there are things you just don't like to do together and give each other the space to chill and pursue hobbies or entertainment. You are a Cardinal sign and your husband is a fixed sign, meaning that you may be less tolerant of his faults and vice versa yet the two of you just don't treat them as fatal flaws and often don't address them until you reach the last straw. Usually life just hums along and you don't notice until something adverse comes up and rocks your world. Similar conditions exist when one sign is before or right after the other, the semi-sextile aspect. Two famous Sun trine Sun marriages are between Prince Charles (Scorpio) and Camilla Parker-Bowles (Cancer) and Tom Hanks (Cancer) and Rita Wilson (Scorpio). Note that Princess Diana was also a Cancer born July 1 although her Sun at 9 degrees of Cancer was too early to trine Charles' 15 degree Scorpio Sun the way Camilla's born July 17th does. In your charts, I see that your Venus in Aries is in harsh (square) aspect to your spouse's Venus in Cancer, so you may disagree over spending and luxury items like vehicles, home purchases and certain entertainment types. Tension can be very healing though and lead to a compromise that helps your marriage endure. Congratulations on your 16 years together.
- Q. I am a 57-year-old Aries (on March 29) and want to work at least 10 more years. I am considering a job change. What should I look for in the next position; qualities of the environment or traits in a boss and what should I avoid?

A. DESIRES: You'll want a good listener for business partnerships or work conditions; someone to bat "clean-up" after you start a project since you like to generate ideas and don't like all the detail work; bosses who appreciate your innovation and opportunities to demonstrate innovation and leadership; frequent promotions; new audiences; bosses who delegate responsibility allowing you to release your creative problem-solving style and opportunities for success via a clear career path. DISLIKES: Work environments where you feel stifled; sticking to timelines when you haven't thought about the detail or plans are sketchy; stale ideas; smothering bosses with a helicopter mom style; a feeling of underachievement (which can sometimes lead to indiscreet love affairs to compensate for the sense of failure). Another dislike is being denied a raise or a bonus when you feel you've earned it; balancing the books (you can be lax in keeping expense records or at least recording your activity when it occurs.) If you are not in a relationship, this could be a year where you meet a mate; if you are, it could be a very romantic cycle. Enjoy!

CONFIDENTIAL TO WANTING NEW FRIENDS: Your Aries chart has Uranus near the Sun this year. No wonder you are ready to ditch stale relationships that keep you tied to your work. Too many of them are from your current work place and some contacts appear to be workaholics. Since you indicated that you find it necessary to turn down certain invitations because you are bored, or because your companions cancel in favor of working overtime, do some inventory on what qualities you prefer in friendships. Aries appreciate friends who give you tickets to ball games or concerts when you need a break from routine as well as those who have plenty of patience to cope with your short temper. Find fun-lovers like you who enjoy parties, host them, or initiate adventure. Move away from wet blankets or those who lack the courage to try something new or won't make decisions about where to go for a meal or a movie. Uranus contacts your Aries Sun in the 5th House of social life creating a variety of disruptions that will shake up the status quo. Do something different each week, accept invitations and be ready to move in new directions. Transiting Saturn in Sagittarius in your 3rd House on your natal Moon (communication, local travel and your mind) helps you break out of the rut and eliminate the restrictions that are around you.
