Five eclipses occur during 2018; two lunar and three solar and two more in January 2019. The signs, Leo and Aquarius are prominent as well as a solar eclipse in Cancer in July 2018 and a solar eclipse in Capricorn in January 2019. You are already under the influence of three of them that occurred prior to your 2018 birthday cycle and will experience one more in July and the last of 2018 eclipses in August. Eclipses begin to take effect months before they actually hit; transits over their degrees start the wheels in motion for the events that unfold in your chart; expect activity I describe in this section to last through the end of 2019. **Eclipses that affect your birthday year started with the January 31st lunar eclipse in Leo which fell in your 1st House** of energy, enthusiasm, personal appearance, innovation, creativity, passion, enterprise, and outlook. With eclipses occurring in this house you may experience numerous events related to these concepts. Many Leos are feeling adventurous and ready to break out of a rut, especially if the eclipse is close to the Ascendant or in the 3rd house of mental activity. Close friends and relatives may be shocked at the changes you are contemplating which may be focused on image or an about-face in attitude. Certain Leos want a drastic makeover. If you are born around the 4th of August, this eclipse may have affected you greatly and stays powerful through the 11th of August eclipse cycle. **The February 15th Solar Eclipse fell in Aquarius in your solar 7th House of business relationships, personal partners like spouses and roommates, collaborators, advisors, medical and legal professionals, open enemies, the public and advisors.** Rifts often occur in relationships; sometimes they are necessary because a partnership is not working. You could find a better match or better business opportunity down the road once you analyze the big picture. This eclipse will help complete old matters that have run their course. By letting go of negative relationships you can look with optimism at the future. Seek people and conditions that represent positive opportunities and help meet your goals. Be sure to consult professionals to walk you through any related legal situations. This eclipse plays out until **July 27th. On July 12, the 2nd Solar Eclipse of the year occurred in Cancer activating your solar 12th House** of behind the scenes activity, secrets, a need for privacy, healing of mind and spirit, metaphysical and psychic matters, widows, hospital visiting, orphans and secret enemies. Since eclipses trigger surprises, don't be shocked if what you are keeping private is suddenly revealed: could be the presence of a lover, a medical condition for you or others, financial matter, pending career or job change, engagement, wedding or divorce plans. Think carefully about any disclosures and what they can mean. This house will be in the limelight over the next 18 months.

Two weeks later, the next full Moon lunar eclipse occurs in Aquarius in your 7th House of business or personal partnerships including spouses, roommates, significant others and collaborators, the public and professional advisors in diverse capacities. This one's significant in the relationship department and could mean: that new people enter your life; people from your past pop in who may be related to this lifetime or previous ones; that you scrutinize budding relationships to make sure you are with the right one; that you seek advice from skilled consultants and/or medical or legal pros as your needs arise. Be sure to check the planets in the rest of your chart for connections. Whatever you started last February may conclude in this cycle. **Bear in mind that Mercury will be turning retrograde** in Leo starting July 26th through August 19th EDT in your 1st house of action, appearance, passion and creativity, so plan

accordingly. The last **Solar Eclipse of 2018 falls on August 11 in Leo in your very personal 1st House so read the passage regarding the February 15 new moon eclipse to determine the relevance of ongoing themes and those that prevailed under the January 31st full moon eclipse. If you were born on or close to August 11, get ready for changes and new beginnings.** Check planets that fall around 18-19 degrees, especially in fixed signs Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius. PLANET ACTIVITY FROM JULY 22-AUGUST 22

The powerful lunar and solar eclipses dominate all planetary activity during the Leo cycle. Shortly after the Sun moves to Leo, actions heat up. **The next Full Moon eclipse takes place on July 27th in Aquarius,** a sign noted for sudden change. It will affect us personally and globally. Leos born around that date (July 26-28) or Aquarius

born January 23-25 should expect shifts in your life; ditto Scorpios born October 26-28 and Taurus born April 24-26 feel a challenging effect since Uranus in Taurus is in hard aspect at the same time, shaking things up in your world. Check out the house in your natal chart where this eclipse occurs to understand the full impact. If you are born on or around the eclipse, or have planets on that degree, the event takes on greater importance. Doors open inviting you to create new plans, address simmering issues or make adjustments in your life. If you have been off-track in your personal life, situations may occur to put you in touch with your sense of belonging. **The partial solar eclipse on August 11 in Leo** will be important to those of you born August 10-12; Taurus born May 8-10, Scorpio born November 9-11 and Aquarius born February 8-10 as well as for those with fixed sign planets around 18 degrees. The eclipse won't be visible in the U.S. Intense global activity drives the cycle we are entering. Safety issues remain of great concern for the country and White House connections and will unfold over the next 6 months. The fiasco taking place is mind-boggling to all who are witnessing the bizarre behavior. Those with big egos set off cries of protest from inner circles and from the greater public. The pressure is on to operate with a more integrity and a generous spirit. **Mercury goes retrograde in Leo from July 26 until August 19; the fact that it occurs right on the door of the July 27 eclipse suggests that you plan activities safely and postpone major activities until the dust settles a few days after the eclipse.** As for the Mercury cycle, follow common sense direction to avoid starting major initiatives or making expensive investments until a few weeks after the vibes pass. Spend the time productively doing your homework, researching options, and obtaining pertinent advice so you'll be ready. Clean out closets, get donations ready for charities, return phone calls and treasure your down time. Apply for new positions either in late August or after Labor Day according to your chart's best dates. **Lady Venus wraps up her tour in resourceful Virgo on August 6 and heads into partner-oriented Libra for the rest of Leo's cycle.** Be sure to discuss organization of personal or workplace space with your loved ones or colleagues to avoid adding tense territorial issues to the mix. Make logical suggestions rather than demanding change and you will experience smooth transitions. **Mars is retrograde in Aquarius and moves into Capricorn late on August 12 before moving direct in Capricorn on August 27.** When both Mercury and Mars station direct, you should find communications and your daily routines running more smoothly. Focus on upbeat matters to mitigate any irritation or tension in personal or business relationships. Identify areas that need attention depending on where these planets fall in your chart. Spontaneity rocks! **Jupiter in Scorpio most affects the charts of Scorpios born November 4-7 while the planet is on your Sun and moves you into a winning cycle by helping to create positive change and possibly windfalls.** Certain Scorpios benefit from financial, relationship and health improvement. Those with planets at 13-15 degrees of Scorpio, Cancer and Pisces boost confidence. Lighten your load by letting go of concepts that no longer make sense to your world or business. Work through challenges if you have planets at 13-15 degrees of Taurus, Leo or Aquarius. Transiting **Saturn in Capricorn is retrograde, and most affects Capricorns born December 23-26 as well as Aries born March 22-25, Cancer born June 20-24, and Libra born September 23-26.** Saturn affects health and family matters, household conditions and responsibility. Those affected will not be able to ignore the obvious. Taurus born April 21-25, Virgo born August 23-26, Pisces born February 20-23 and Scorpios born October 23-25 benefit from wise counsel and judicious restructuring of plans. **Uranus in Taurus is in its early days of the trek through this sign which will last around 7 years. Right now Uranus is shaking things**

up for Taurus born April 19-22. Other signs feeling challenging vibes are Leos born July 23-26, Scorpio born October 23-26 and Aquarius born January 19-23. On August 7, Uranus makes a station and goes retrograde on August 7 until January 6, 2019, also the date of the first eclipse of next year. Hang on to your hats. When Uranus goes direct it will be back in Aries for a few months giving late born Aries a chance to clean up any lingering issues from the first few months of this year. Early born members of Cardinal signs Cancer and Capricorn may benefit from this transit as will Virgos and Pisces in important life areas as they work on solid goals and new beginnings. A retrograde period provides opportunities to get to the heart of the matter on a personal or global level. Rather than making drastic changes, it is best to look at how internal systems are operating before you leap to avoid making poor decisions. Leaders will be looking for new concepts, technologies and systems for fostering cohesive relationships with contacts. Although briefly, Saturn is in trine aspect to Uranus for a few weeks or the shakeups would be more exhausting. **Neptune is retrograde in Pisces at 16-15 degrees.** Check the houses in your chart where Pisces falls and if it is in a money house (2nd, 8th or 10th), be sure to monitor your assets, spending habits, retirement funds, credit card usage, bank balances and computers especially when Mercury goes retrograde on July 26th right ahead of the Aquarius eclipse on July 27th. **Those born March 5-8 are most affected followed by those born June 5-8, September 7-10 and December 6-9.** Make security a priority. Jupiter in Scorpio is loving the sextile aspect so plan a vacation or weekend getaway that adds quality to your life. Honesty goes a long way in personal or business relationships. **Pluto in Capricorn is enjoying a compatible relationship with transiting Jupiter in Scorpio that benefits both business enterprises and those in search of a new work position or status change.** This transit most affects those born January 9-11, April 8-10, July 10-12, and October 11-13. Since the current degree opposes the degree of the July 12th eclipse, world tension surfaces if leaders let egos get in the way of harmony or use bullying tactics to control outcomes. It is wise to build an environment of confidence rather than enmity. Good manners never go out of style. Let Pluto shine as the great transformer while promoting unity to heal the planet. **Retrograde Chiron in Aries is especially sensitive for individuals born March 20-23.** By meditating on your vulnerabilities, you find solutions for the internal angst that has kept you mentally at odds with the way you want your life to flow. Make no mistake about it, you asked about several topics of interest, but nothing dominated your questions across all political and economic lines like the scenario in

The White House. Please check news feeds for full coverage. Here are this month's offerings.

Mt. Kilauea on the Big Island of Hawaii has seen violent volcanic eruptions since May 3. Not surprisingly, this fast-moving lava activity is creating mounds of fiery rock that look like they could be new volcanos; geologists are watching carefully. Such activity falls under the watch of Uranus (sudden eruptions) which moved into Taurus on May 15 and which will occupy this sign for the next 7 years. Hawaii is a Leo state established August 21, 1959. Recent eclipse activity had direct hits on Hawaii's Leo Sun and the August 11 eclipse falls directly on natal Uranus in Leo in the state chart; in January, the lunar eclipse of the 31st fell directly on Hawaii's Mercury (blustery wind and erratic storm patterns); Hawaii's Jupiter in Scorpio felt the blast from the initial February 10, 2017 lunar eclipse and its Neptune (monsoon-like rains) will be on the challenging path of the upcoming July 27th eclipse in Aquarius. Looks like more eruptions are probable. Stay tuned.

The Helsinki Summit was a bust, left Congress and all government experts agape while going down in history as fostering the death of American foreign policy. It is impossible to summarize in a paragraph or two let alone believe most of what we witnessed in the past few weeks that has been tweeted, retweeted, altered to fit a better agenda, redacted and deemed preposterous by those following and reporting the news who have been told how “successful” the outcomes of these events are. Late night comics continue to parody and remind us of the eye-rolling behavior that unfolds each day causing jaws to drop in shock and awe. Rampant anxiety prevails over lack of leadership and clear understanding of what it takes to bring unity to the U.S. Many readers want a reprieve from the polarizing and disruptive politics that have become a daily fixture. Activities in the astrology charts of key figures described in earlier newsletters are unfolding. So many of those whose charts were featured last summer are gone from the scene. Look for more disruptions and shocking headlines in the next month. May truth set us free.

READERS' CORNER

Several readers wrote regarding hard aspects in their charts and wanted to know more about how long they last and when they'll turn a corner for relief from harsh patterns or conditions in their work or love lives. This month's queries revolved largely around transiting Uranus as in the work example. Another involves a sudden encounter that is in a holding pattern. What you think?

Q. I am 49 years old and made a career change to another organization in April that I considered a perfect fit for my background. Things were going well but by mid-June, I no longer recognized the work environment I joined: I have a new boss, was transferred to a different position on July 2 and now have a whole new set of work colleagues and am not using my talent to my advantage. The new boss started reorganizing the work flow within two weeks of his arrival - he came from outside the organization. Twice a week he schedules meetings about the time most of the work force is ready to call it quits for the day and expects us to stick around. The only good thing is they don't last too long. I feel completely out of my comfort zone yet feel it would be premature to look for a new job and resign. What is going on with my chart that triggered all this change? Do you think it will end soon? I am a Leo born July 23. Thank you.

A. My first thought when I read that your new boss is cleaning house so soon after his arrival and making changes is that his haste is going to cost him down the road. How is the rest of the staff taking his blitz? HR can get very busy down the road. Maybe you can find out his date of birth, so we can get greater insight into his style next time we talk. You are a Leo born with an early Leo Ascendant in hard aspect to your 10th House of career and authority figures that has early Taurus, a fixed sign on the cusp. Your other angles, the 4th House of home and foundations has Scorpio on it while your 7th House of partners has early Aquarius on the cusp. You were born with the Moon in early Scorpio in your 4th House accompanied by late Neptune in Scorpio. Your 1st House shows Mercury in very early Leo and your 10th House has Saturn in Taurus, also in an early degree. The reason for the abundant disruption in your life is that on May 15, the planet of chaos, Uranus, moved into Taurus in your 10th House of bosses, career dynamics, ambition, authority and status in life. Simultaneously this

transit affected all four of the chart angles I mentioned earlier - 1st, 4th and 7th Houses and aspects each of the early planets I cited. Uranus stays in a sign for approximately 7 years so it doesn't cover an abundant amount of territory in a given year, but it can hit the same points several times during the duration of the transit. On August 7, Uranus is going to go retrograde and that means it will go back over the same degrees it did for the past few months. On July 27th, an eclipse at 4 degrees of Aquarius will land on your 7th House of partners, advisors, collaborators, and the public and will also affect your 10th House of career. Don't be surprised if the boss makes another move or two some of which could be erratic and short-lived. If you decide to stay, it will be mid-2020 before you are free of this undesirable energy. I am not sure your boss will last though, simply because your chart indicates you could have 2 or more authority figures in your life in the next two years. It looks like training will be in the picture this fall. Go for it; it may be your ticket to a more compatible work environment and possibly meeting a potential executive that you respect.

Q. I met a new woman in May at a party. We talked a lot and seemed to click so I asked her for her phone number and offered her mine. She told me she was not ready to exchange contact information, so I let it go after telling her that she might be missing a chance to meet her soul mate. A month later a friend who attended the same party told me the woman was interested in contacting me. I am not sure I still want to pursue her and told mutual friend I would think about it and get back to her. Should I follow up anyway? I found out that she is a Leo and I am an Aries and I know those signs are compatible. I don't know her year of birth, but one of two years is likely.

A. You are an Aries with Mercury in Taurus while your friend is a Leo with Mercury in Cancer, one of the reasons you were able to chat amiably at the party (based on vague information you supplied). If you set a date with this woman and the two of you decide you want to see more of each other, then I recommend a chart analysis to focus on the compatibilities and the potential areas of conflict. You are not yet sure of her year of birth, so I would wait until you have more information and know more about one another. Find out her interests, what she likes to do on dates and her daily environment. Then you may be ready for an analysis. You could very well be correct about meeting a soul mate because your chart starts popping early next year. If this woman is not the one, then after January you should find more harmonious partners entering your life. Enjoy the adventure!
