This year eclipses affect all four angles of your solar chart since you are a Cardinal sign and are undergoing a rebuilding from the inside out. The eclipse helps you take stock of current routines and collaborative work. How do family members participate or help in running the household? Evaluate their talents for goodness of fit. A full moon lunar eclipse occurs on July 16 in pragmatic Capricorn at 24 degrees, 04 minutes in your solar 10th House of career, ambition, attitude toward authority figures, leadership, family and the status quo. This eclipse could shakes things up in your employing organization. Some of you welcome a new boss; others rue the new energy and figure out ways to cope. PLANETS IN ARIES' TIME from March 20-April 20

On March 20th at 5:59 PM EDT we'll welcome spring as the Sun moves to Aries while the momentum of the January 5th and 21st eclipses continues to have a strong impact on many lives. Shortly after we enter Aries and celebrate the equinox, we look forward to the direct motion of Mercury, the planet of communication and transportation that has been retrograde in dreamy Pisces since March 5th, Mercury goes direct on March 28 at 9:59 AM EDT. Hope you spent the time catching up on projects you have already initiated, clearing clutter, seeking advice for the months ahead, reading or organizing paperwork. Be sure to check tax returns carefully. As many have reported, the Mercury effect began two weeks before and sticks around for about two weeks after it goes direct. Table surgery that is not an emergency as well as major purchases. Tackle filing and sort through piles of accumulating material, shredding unnecessary documents, phoning a friend, and staying calm when appointments are canceled and rescheduled. The latter items always seem confusing during this period. You can be sure if you were sitting on important paperwork during the Mercury retrograde period, you will resume your output of communication in all forms now. Venus completes a stint in congenial Aguarius and moves to romantic Pisces on March 27th where it stays through April 20th the starting date of the Taurus cycle. Dating should be fun and may include movies, comedies, dramas and unique restaurants. Mars reigns in energy in cautious Taurus who is taking no chances with Uranus now in that sign and leaves for Gemini on March 31st where it stays for the rest of the Aries cycle. Be on the lookout for volatile conditions from April 12-14 involving Mars and Pluto. Tempers flare. Jupiter is direct now in Sagittarius but goes retrograde on April 10th through August 11th now affecting those of you born December 14-17; favorably affecting Aries born April 12-15; Leos born August 16-19, Libras born October 16-19, and Aquarius born February 11-14. Check

your charts for wherever you find 23-24 degrees of Sagittarius. Meanwhile Jupiter challenges mutable signs Gemini, Virgo and Pisces born with planets at 23-24 degrees of their respective signs. Check the tremendous volume of unresolved energy that clogs progress related to government and global enterprise. The current transit of Jupiter calls for reflection and judicious use of mojo, luck and opportunity. Create personal prosperity and look for ways to improve techniques that work best for your money and resources. If looking for a new job, sign up for courses that build your skill set. Leaders must be mindful of the impact their decisions have on the moral fiber and cultural differences of citizens. Jupiter relates strongly to goal expansion - what a good time to improve the quality of life. Although Saturn has moved to high middegrees in Capricorn it will head into retrograde motion in late April, Right now it is dancing with Pluto in Capricorn (also going retrograde in late April) via conjunction and the energy between them is very intense in April. Areas of responsibility emerge bringing a serious attitude for matters affiliated with pending decisions involving career, family, financial and physical health, real estate and authority. Note the urgent need to criticize unethical behavior and insist on accountability for erratic revision of laws, political structures, arms agreements and leadership on the world stage. Individuals benefit from attention to detail and tweaking plans, especially in areas where they feel stuck. Nothing will change without a thorough analysis of the situation you're in, so examine the lessons and formulate solutions. Implementation of changes works better in the fall. Those most affected during the next month by Saturn's transit are Capricorns born January 9-12; Aries born April 8-11, Cancers born July 11-14 and Libras born October 12-15. Responsibilities may increase for many born on these dates. Earth signs Taurus and Virgo experience favorable periods especially if born with planets at 19-20 degrees of their signs; ditto Pisces and Scorpio with these degrees. For now decide how to solve problems and develop priorities. It is time to build on rather than initiate new plans. Watch the news; it could create erratic messages the last 7 days of March. Thank goodness Saturn has a nice sextile going with Neptune to bring financial and emotional relief to those who need a helping hand. Uranus in Taurus is at the beginning stages of its 7-year journey in this sign which re-entered Taurus on March 6 and finally left impatient Aries. Currently those born at April 19-22 degrees of Taurus will be most affected. Also having strong aspects are Cancers born June 21-24, Virgos born August 22-25, Capricorns born December 21-24 and Pisces born February 18-21. Other fixed signs - Leos born July 22-25, Scorpios born October 23-25 and Aquarius born January 19-22 deal with challenges, mixed messages or erratic communication. Look at house cusps or planets where you have 0-2 degrees of these signs and be sure to take stock of current conditions. Surprises and/or the unexpected occurs depending on where these numbers appear in your chart. Security and safety are high on the list of topics in the news. Neptune in Pisces coasts along at 16-17 degrees over the next month and most affects those born March 6-9. Others affected harmoniously include Cancers and Scorpios born with planets at these degrees. Challenged signs in this cycle are Geminis born June 6-9. Virgos born September 8-11 and Sagittarius born December 7-10. Neptune makes harmonious

connections to Venus in Pisces from March 27-April 20 and to Saturn in Capricorn related to spiritual and humanitarian efforts during this cycle. A few days after this forecast period ends Pluto goes retrograde (April 24) in Capricorn at 23 degrees making its annual 6-month journey into retrograde motion and goes direct on October 2, 2019 at 20 degrees. Many individuals feel the vibes in advance and start cleaning out their stash of secrets. Cardinal signs Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn feel the intensity on planets around 23 degrees of their signs, located in the last decanate. Those born January 12-15 experience the shift on their suns over the next 6 months and beyond. If you have been dealing with personal pain, pick a course of action that allows you to begin with a fresh perspective. Globally, the station on the 24th could focus on the angst related to unexpected attacks on citizens, dissatisfaction over disappearing benefits, political unrest and conflicts in ideology. If your life seems overwhelming it is no surprise since you will experience the tension of Cardinal Sign eclipses in Capricorn and Cancer this year, especially the one on December 26 if you are a member of a Cardinal sign and your Sun falls in the first few degrees. PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

Have you felt all the high drama and rapid change that is blasting through the Universe? You can give much of the credit to the waning intensity of Uranus leaving Aries and moving into Taurus that took place on March 6. Uranus takes a turbulent seven-year ride through each sign hacking away at old standings and concepts that need new life. We saw sweeping reforms in the realm of social medial - some terrific and convenient yet others invasive and restrictive. Blogs went viral; so have Tweets, U-Tube and mass networking. The last hurrah in Aries ushered in a huge tornado in Alabama, a near-miss for a Norwegian cruise ship, even greater demand from

Democrats for scandal-related documents critical to the Mueller report, massive cold spells producing record snow storms, and a resurgence of an old Michael Jackson scandal revolving around alleged child abuse from now adult victims. The event chart showed a tight conjunction of Mercury, the Sun and the Midheaven, Mercury ruling the chart via Gemini on the Ascendant, Saturn and Pluto in the 8th House of death, solo Uranus in the 11th house in aspect to the Moon in Cancer late in the 1st House, 7th House Jupiter in Sagittarius in hard aspect to the Mercury/Sun/MC in the 10th with Part of Fortune in the 3rd House of communication. The terrorist wanted attention and deliberately intended to broadcast his voluminous manifesto of hatred by streaming it live on social media and destroying the spirit of the Muslims. While his horrible act shocked the New Zealand community, it actually resulted in an outpouring of love, support and acceptance for all rather than destroying the soul of this Muslim community. The New Zealand culture embraces diversity and lovingly supports over 200 ethnicities. This tragedy has instead stimulated the need for even greater spiritual and cultural growth as residents bond in compassion and strength.

READERS CORNER

Fans of Readers Corner wrote mostly about personal matters related to their natal charts and asked specific questions - see below. They also commented on the generous Pisces spouse who shared her bonus with family members by treating them to a holiday getaway; most were critical of her mother-in-law's attitude. Others talked about the selection of letters for the column as well as the list of top themes from readers and said they pretty well matched their own perceptions of "hot topics." Enjoy the questions for this month. How do they relate to your life?

- Q. I am an Aries born April 6 and have been struggling with loss of friendships and professional contacts. Lately I've also become disappointed with leadership in organizations I have belonged to for a number of years. My chief complaint is that it takes too long to accomplish goals because enthusiasm seems to be flagging once we set targets and agreed upon plans are dropped without follow through so that goals are not met. My boss chairs one of the groups and I find myself in disagreement over his decisions and unsure about remaining a member. Certain friends have let me down by canceling engagements, not being available for social events, not returning phone calls and often not agreeing to proposed activity. I don't always feel I am being told the truth about why they cancel plans. I have noticed these trends for over a year. Please provide insight on what is happening in my chart to create these situations.
- A. Thank you for writing. As for friendships, sometimes individuals grow out of them and develop new interests. Q. What is in my chart that is causing confusion over my prescribed medications? I would also call the pharmacist to discuss the number of errors occurring in a little over a year. Mistakes like this can be costly and harmful. Good thing you are alert and read what is on the bottle before taking a pill. You could also switch to another pharmacy if you feel there is lack of quality control. First you need answers. Work diligently on this to clear up the issue and restore confidence in medical care.
