# CANCER and THE YEAR AHEAD

Happy Birthday, Cancer! Saturn rules Capricorn, often a sign of a shift in responsibilities. Situations you have been dealing with since late 2017 and especially since January's solar eclipse, surface and move toward much needed action and completion. #### THE PLANETS' ACTIVITY JUNE 21-July 22, 2018

The Summer Solstice occurs on June 21 at 11:55 AM EDT, the longest day of the year. Two eclipses occur during the Cancer cycle. The next solar eclipse cycle

begins with the New Moon Eclipse in Cancer on July 2 and the next Full Moon eclipse takes place on July 16 in Capricorn. If your birthday is on or around these eclipse dates or you have planets in Cancer, Capricorn, Libra or Aries around 11 or 24 degrees, the year may be exceptionally eventful for you. The Ascendant or the Moon play a big role if an eclipse falls on, opposes or squares either; ditto, the door to the  $4^{\text{th}}$  or 10<sup>th</sup> Houses. Eclipses strongly affect countries and leaders with planets in the eclipse signs. Look now at Sudan, Algeria, Burundi, Somalia, Venezuela and Zaire. Keep an eye on activity involving Iran and Irag as conditions heat up for conflict. Hold off making any important decisions until a week after the eclipses occur. Remember that eclipses take 6 months to a year to play out and a lot can happen during their cycles. Mercury the messenger is completing a fast transit in Cancer through June 26<sup>th</sup> emphasizing family matters, reunions, social gatherings and food management before moving to Leo and turning retrograde at 4°Leo on July 7 and then moving back to Cancer on July 20, where it stays during the rest of Cancer's cycle and moves direct on July 31<sup>st</sup> at 11:58 PM EDT. Be prepared to alter plans, travel, deadlines and appointment schedules. Currently, four retrograde planets are traveling the heavens - Jupiter, Saturn, Neptune and Pluto, to be joined by Mercury on July 7. Check appointments and proofread documents on June 21-26 when Mars makes hard aspects to Mercury. Venus travels in Gemini until July 4<sup>th</sup> and moves into Cancer through the remainder of the Cancer cycle. The vibes are celebratory and call for fun, parties, romance and sociable connections especially if you have Venus or other planets in these signs. Mars occupies Cancer until July 2<sup>nd</sup> and moves to Leo for the remainder of the Cancer cycle and promises good humor, playtime, passion and games for those clamoring for a work break. Look at your chart to see where these two signs are present and examine ways to go after your heart's desire. Mars creates positive aspects to Mercury until Mercury goes retrograde on July 7 and alters the pace of your momentum. Watch the world stage with this aspect which could set the stage for shifts in agreements, political ideology and control. Avoid those who stretch the truth. If you have this conjunction in your chart, avoid conflict with others. Jupiter is retrograde in Sagittarius and will go direct in August while positively affecting Sagittarians born December 6-9; Leos born August 8-11, Aries born April 4-7, Libras born October 8-12 and Aquarius born February 4-7. Those experiencing challenges include Pisces born March 3-6, Geminis born June 6-9, and Virgos born September 7-11. Jupiter travels in a hard aspect to Neptune this month reminding us to avoid public or political deception and to review facts carefully before making decisions. Saturn in Capricorn travels near the Moon's South Node as it nears the eclipse degree occurring on July 16. Saturn is in retrograde motion affecting those of you born January 6-11 as well as cardinal signs Aries, Cancer and Libra born with Sun, Moon or planets at 15-19 degrees of these signs. You feel the effects if you are a member of these signs and have planets on these degrees. Cardinal signs are in the spotlight now with the number of cardinal planets in opposition or square to one another. The first eclipse in the emerging cycle falls in Cancer on July 2. Make domestic decisions wisely and communicate clearly avoiding emotional outbursts. Gravitate toward activities that bring joy to family situations. Core issues come up for examination and call for solutions especially if you are born January 6-11. Work with intuitive insight that accompanies a favorable transit from Neptune. Keep an eye on medical and physical ailments that affect mobility and need attention. Let go of the past to find peace of mind. Uranus in Taurus travels over the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> degrees this month giving your mind or plans a good jolt if you take things for granted. Taurus born April 25-28 are most affected now as are Aquarians born January 24-27, Leos born July 28-31 and Scorpios born October 28-30 with Uranus in hard aspect. If you are a mutable sign, Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius or Pisces born with planets at 18 degrees of your sign, be cautious when signing papers, considering major purchases, negotiating agreements or entering new relationships. Review Capricorn's house in your chart to note where Pluto is traveling and identify what makes you feel stuck. Pluto is most powerful around the July 16 eclipse which connects with the degrees Pluto is now transiting. Table major decisions either right before or for at least a week after the eclipse - you'll find that vital information is missing that is crucial to your plans. Select dates for surgery carefully. Chiron in Aries is direct until July 9 when it moves into retrograde motion. Right now it affects the charts of Aries born March 25-27 and challenges you to find answers to persistent dilemmas. ### PEOPLE, PLACES, EVENTS, AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The Gemini newsletter generated several comments on current events, the new baby in the Royal Family, activity in our government and questions about the players on the world stage. Many readers enjoyed the information about James Holzhauer, Doris Day and the American Idol Show.

**Venezuela:** This country has been dominating the headlines in 2019 since the January 5<sup>th</sup> eclipse and transiting Saturn in Capricorn opposed its Cancer sun. The upcoming July 2 eclipse is conjunct its natal Sun listed as July 5, 1811. The battle for leadership plays out between President Nicolas Maduro and his opponent Juan Guaido (who declared himself the national leader in January 2019 and was supported by 50

countries including the U.S. while Russia and China continue to back Maduro) in the timeframe through next spring. Hyperinflation is plaguing the national economy causing many citizens to flee the country for other South American nations, the U.S. and Spain. Stay tuned.

**Gloria Vanderbilt Cooper:** This talented artist, fashion designer, actress, author, heiress, and much married socialite was born on February 20 in New York City and died on June 17 surrounded by family and friends. In the 30's she was known as "the poor little rich girl" in a bitter custody battle between her globe-trotting mother and matriarchal aunt, Gertrude Vanderbilt Whitney, who was granted custody of her niece. Gloria is the mother of CNN anchor, Anderson Cooper. She claimed her only successful marriage was to his father, Wyatt Cooper. Many of us buy and wear her trendy jeans, the fashion item everyone wanted to own when they made their debut in the 1970's. Ms. Vanderbilt died of advanced stomach Cancer. Her natal chart shows Pluto in Cancer at 10+ degrees (slow growing cancer that was probably there for a long time), at the degree of the upcoming July 2 eclipse. Besides her talent in design and art, she acted on stage in several venues and on numerous television shows and wrote books. The world will miss this talented icon.

**Cancer Women in 2020 Presidential Race:** One of the latest entrants to the race among Democrats is Marianne Williamson, a Cancer born July 8 who aspires to create a new political possibility that elevates the standards of American democracy. Ms. Williamson is an American author (13 books), lecturer and activist who was born with a powerful Uranus, Sun, Venus conjunction in Cancer, the Moon in late Capricorn, Jupiter in Taurus, several planets or points in Leo and Libra and passionate Mars in Scorpio. Elizabeth Warren is another Cancer born June 22 also with a Uranus, Sun, Part of Fortune conjunction in Cancer, Juno and Venus in Cancer, the Moon in Taurus, Mars and Mercury in Gemini (communication), a Leo Ascendant with Pallas and Pluto in Cancer, Saturn and Ceres in the 1<sup>st</sup> House in Virgo and Jupiter in Aquarius in her 6<sup>th</sup> House of daily activity. She is potently qualified as a financial advocate with her fine analytical mind and thorough study of issues. Senator Warren read the entire eyeopening Mueller Report. ### **READERS' CORNER**

Thank you for the many questions, feedback and comments you sent during the past month highlighting the woman who wanted help on solving problems affiliated with in-law visits that lasted a month or more at a time. It can take from 12-20 years to get through one sign, so an entire Pluto cycle takes approximately 248 years to move through every sign. Pluto is in Capricorn now and moved into this sign January 26, 2008 (teaser entry and moved retrograde back into Sagittarius) before its ultimate entry on November 27, 2008. Pluto will finally leave Capricorn on November 20, 2024. This planet spends six months of each year in retrograde motion and moves only about 3 degrees per year, which is why it takes so long to move through a sign and why you will never repeat these aspects in your lifetime once you complete this long cycle. The last time Pluto was in Capricorn was 1776, 233 years ago when America won her independence from England! Now Pluto is nearing the degree of the U.S. Pluto called a Pluto return and stirs the pot of foreign relations that need attention. In your chart, the first conjunction of Pluto to your Sun dropped hints to fix your physical body and get to the bottom of uncertainty in personal relationships. Now Pluto is on your natal Moon at the same time as the July 2 Solar eclipse nears the position of your Sun.
